



STATE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACTORS

LA. R.S. Title 37:2150-2192

RESIDENTIAL BUILDER LICENSES

- Residences \$75,000 and above
- Application must be completed
- Financial Statement with \$10,000 net worth
- Applicant must take business/law exam
- Applicant must take residential building exam
- Provide Proof of General Liability & Workman's Compensation Insurance
- 4 Hours of continuing education required each year after initial licensing
- Compliance with contractor's licensing law

COMMERCIAL BUILDING LICENSE

- Commercial work \$50,000 and above
- Application must be completed
- Financial Statement with \$10,000 net worth
- Must take Business/Law Exam
- Must take Trade exam
- Compliance with contractor's licensing law
- Hire licensed subcontractors \$50,000

SPECIALTY TRADE/SUBCONTRACTOR LICENSE

- Commercial projects \$50,000 & Up
- Application must be completed
- Financial Statement with \$10,000 net worth
- Business and Law Examination
- Specialty Trade Examination
- Compliance with contractor's licensing law

HOME IMPROVEMENT REGISTRATION

- Residential projects \$7,500 up to \$75,000 max ,above this requires a
- Residential Builders License
- Application must be completed
- \$65.00 application and processing fee
- Provide Proof of Workman's Compensation Insurance
- Provide resident/non-resident contractor status from local taxing authority
- Maintain compliance to contractor's licensing law

MOLD REMEDIATION LICENSING

- \$1.00 & above contracting
- Must complete application
- Must Provide General Liability & Workman's Compensation Insurance
- Financial Statement. \$10,000 net worth
- Must provide 24 Hours mold remediation and mold assessment training certification
- Provide 4 Hours of unfair trade practices and consumer protection act training
- Must take Business & Law Examination
