WHEREAS, George was highly respected and admired for his passion and determination to always do what he felt was best for the good of the citizens of Iberia Parish.

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. JOHN RAINES AS PLANNING, ZONING AND PERMITTING DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR, AT AN ANNUAL SALARY OF \$60,000 AND, IN ADDITION, AUTHORIZING A MONTHLY CAR ALLOWANCE OF \$500 PER MONTH, AND FURTHER AMENDING THE 2009 GENERAL FUND BUDGET IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$4,000 TO INCLUDE CAR ALLOWANCE FUNDING FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE YEAR, ALL TO BE FUNDED FROM THE 2009 GENERAL FUND BUDGET, FUND BALANCE - PREVIOUS YEARS.

WHEREAS, the Parish President has requested Council ratification of the appointment of Mr. John Raines as the Director of the Planning, Zoning and Permitting Department for the executive branch at an annual salary of \$60,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby approve and ratify the appointment of Mr. John Raines as Director of the Planning, Zoning and Permitting Department of the Executive Branch at an annual salary of \$60,000, effective on May 1, 2009, all as requested and recommended by the Parish President.

INITIAL DISCUSSION ITEMS:

ITEM #2009-05-D (Introduced by Barry Verret, District 8)

The Council considered action for the development of a policy for the issuance of Resolutions of condolences. Mr. Verret explained that suggestions for the policy have been placed with each Council member for their review and it was directed that this Ordinance be prepared for publication for the next meeting.

ITEM #2009-05-E (Introduced by Jerome Fitch, District 11)

Also considered was possible action regarding a request to the Louisiana Legislature for special legislation to allow for the annual dedication of a portion of the State hotel/motel occupancy tax revenues to be used by the Acadiana Fairgrounds Commission for the operation of its facilities. Discussion was held with Ms. Fran Thibodeaux, Director of the Tourist Commission, and by direction of Mr. Fitch, a Resolution will be scheduled for consideration at the next meeting requesting special legislation to change the maximum cap of State sales taxes distributed in Iberia Parish from the Visitor Enterprise Fund from \$225,000 to \$425,000.

ITEM #2009-05-F (Introduced by Bernard E. Broussard, District 6)

Also considered was action regarding a request to the City of New Iberia for the sharing of the cost of the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Jefferson Terrace and Dale Streets. At the direction of Mr. Broussard, a Resolution will be scheduled for the next meeting requesting that the City of New Iberia provide an updated cost estimate for the purchase and installation of this signal.

ITEM #2009-05-G

The Council then reviewed a list of possible Ordinances authorizing the levy of the following millages at the same rates as the 2008 levy, as follows:

- (a) Courthouse and Jail Property Millage, in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a millage rate of 0.80 mills;
- (b) General Parish Property Millage (formerly known as the General Alimony Millage), in the rural areas of the Parish only, at a millage rate of 3.43 mills;
- (c) the Exempted Municipalities Property Millage (formerly known as the Criminal Tax Millage), in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a millage rate of 1.71 mills;
- (d) Drainage Facilities Property Millage, for parishwide property, at a millage rate of 3.11 mills;
- (e) Fire Protection District No. 1 Property Millage, for the rural areas only, at a millage rate of 6.50 mills;
- (f) Health Unit Property Millage, for parishwide property, at a millage rate of 1.50 mills;
- (g) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, at a millage rate of 4.58 mills;
- (h) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, to be used to pay outstanding debt for the Parish Library System, at a millage rate of 0.45 mills;
- (I) Public Buildings Maintenance Millage, for parishwide property, at a millage rate of 4.53 mills.

It was agreed by general consensus that these ordinances be introduced for publication at the next Council meeting.

COUNCIL MEMBERS/PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Naray Hulin requested that the Administration prepare information regarding the TIF Districts for review by the Council at a future meeting, including identifying the area to be declared into the District.
2. The Council Clerk provided reminders of Hurricane Meeting on Tuesday, May 19 by Administration and of Hurricane Advisory Committee meeting of said date at 5:15 p.m.
3. Mr. Boudoin questioned the Parish President's authority to write letters opposing Senate Bill No. 317 on behalf of Iberia Parish Government with no prior vote of the Council on record regarding the issue.
4. The Parish President reviewed several announcements.

ORDINANCES INTRODUCED FOR PUBLICATION:

SUMMARY NO. 4103 (Introduced by Maggie Daniels, District 1)

An Ordinance amending Section 2-19.1 of the Iberia Parish Compiled Ordinances to revise the policy requiring Council approval for all contracts which provide for group health insurance benefits for Parish employees to include provisions for an advisory committee to include employees to assist with review of available options annually, contingent upon review and approval by the District Attorney's Office.

SUMMARY NO. 4104 (Introduced by Lloyd Brown, District 4)

An Ordinance amending Section 2-33 of the Iberia Parish Compiled Ordinances to revise the Liability Insurance Policy Procedures to revise the schedule for submission of items to the Council and to establish an advisory committee to include two Council members, all contingent upon review and approval by the District Attorneys' Office.

SUMMARY NO. 4107 (Introduced by Glenn Romero, District 9)

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2009-03-4100, which amended Chapter 16 of the Compiled Ordinances of Iberia Parish to authorize an increase in the speed limit from 35 mph to 45 mph on Northside Road, in order to continue said reduction of speed limit on Danielle Road from its intersection with Vida Shaw Road to its end at Bridge Street, District 9.

SUMMARY NO. 4108 (Introduced by Barry Verret, District 8)
