ITEM #2010-07-Q (Introduced by Tommy Landry, District 3)  
Discuss and consider action regarding the legality of various grants from the State's Visitor Enterprise Fund for Iberia Parish as each grant relates to tourism.

Mr. Thomas J. Landry expressed his concern that the State Statute directs that funds in this account are reserved for the Iberia Parish Tourist Commission to be utilized for tourism purposes. Mr. Landry pointed out that some of the agencies named in a letter from Senator Troy Hebert are listed to receive funds from the Enterprise Fund and feels that these agencies could not utilize said funds for tourism purposes.

Mr. Lloyd Brown stated that he felt that agencies, such as the Council on Aging, provide various activities for tourists, some of who may be Senior Citizens.

Mr. Naray Hulin pointed out that the Parish has been appropriated this funding and we should utilize it for those purposes. Mr. Charles Williams stated that he felt these funds would help the community.

Mr. Troy Comeaux questioned the liability of accepting funds, as described in Senator Hebert's letter, if the State Statute prohibits the use of this funding for purposes other than tourism.

Upon questioning, Finance Director Kimberly Segura stated that some of the funding from the State goes directly to the agency and does not come through the Parish. Ms. Segura stated further that for Parish grants, various information and reports must be submitted to the State as part of the process for receiving said grants.

Tourist Commission Director Fran Thibodeaux pointed out that the State had granted funding to the Festivals Association, which was funneled through the Tourist Commission. Ms. Thibodeaux stated that they have requested that Legislative Delegation to amend this process to allow that the funding go directly to the agency instead of through the Tourist Commission as it is a tedious procedure to provide information and reports to the State.

Mr. Naray Hulin pointed out that these funds are contingent upon matching funding by the agency in order to complete the awarding of the funds.

Upon questioning by Mr. John Berard regarding whether these funds could be utilized for tourism development and economic development, it was pointed out that the State Statute includes only tourism

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE RULING BY U. S. FEDERAL JUDGE MARTIN FELDMAN, WHICH OVERTURNED THE DEEPWATER DRILLING MORATORIUM AND TO REQUEST THAT NO FURTHER APPEALS BE FILED IN RELATION TO JUDGE FELDMAN'S RULING AND THAT NO FURTHER MORATORIUMS BE ORDERED RELATED TO THIS OIL SPILL IN THE FUTURE.

WHEREAS, the Deepwater Horizon Drilling Rig exploded on April 20, 2010 resulting in a catastrophic fire and the release of oil into the Gulf of Mexico; and

WHEREAS, in the aftermath of the British Petroleum (BP) Oil Spill, the Obama Administration ordered a six-month moratorium on existing Gulf of Mexico deep-water drilling on May 27, 2010; and

WHEREAS, said moratorium resulted in the immediate suspension of operations at thirty-three (33) rigs in the Gulf of Mexico; and

WHEREAS, the moratorium on offshore deep-water drilling will cause significant harm to Louisiana's energy service industry as well as to the many coastal communities already suffering tremendously from the environmental and economic impacts of the BP oil spill; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2010, U. S. Federal Judge Martin Feldman overturned said six-month moratorium; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number 2010-175, dated June 9, 2010, urged President Barack Obama to reduce the six-month drilling moratorium to no more than thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Iberia Parish Council that no further appeals be filed relating to Judge Feldman's ruling; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Iberia Parish Council that no future moratoriums be ordered relating the BP Oil Spill in the Gulf of Mexico in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby support the ruling of U. S. Federal Judge Martin Feldman, which overturned the Gulf of Mexico drilling moratorium.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby request that no further appeals be filed in relation to Judge Feldman's ruling.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby request that no further moratoriums be ordered in relation to the BP Oil Spill in the Gulf of Mexico.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Iberia Parish Congressional and Legislative Delegations, the Police Jury Association of Louisiana, and all Parishes in Louisiana.
