AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2010-12-4234, ADOPTED DECEMBER 1, 2010, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE WATER WORKS DISTRICT NO. 4 BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2010-12-4234, adopted December 1, 2010, provided for the creation of Waterworks District No. 4 of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana.

SECTION 2. The Parish has advertised and made appointments to said board, with said terms of members to be determined at the initial meeting of the Board.

SECTION 3. That the following paragraph is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 3. In accordance with the provisions of Article I, Sections 1-04 and 1-05 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter, a five (5) member Board of Waterworks Commissioners, is hereby appointed as the governing authority of the District, each of whom is a resident of the District and own lands assessed at not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in the District, as shown by the assessment roll of the Parish of Iberia, for the year 2007, the same being the last assessment roll completed, filed and of record at this time.

ITEM #2011-05-D (Introduced by Roger Duncan, District 10)

Discuss and consider action to authorize that the limestone located at parish-owned property near the SugArena facility be relocated to the PepperPlex to be used for parking lot material.

Chairman Roger Duncan relinquished the Chair to Vice-Chairman Bernard E. Broussard in order to discuss this matter.

Mr. Duncan explained that he was requested to consider moving some limestone which was brought to the former site of the proposed Waste Water Treatment Plant Project at the SugArena and donating said limestone to the PepperPlex for use for parking lot expansion. Mr. Duncan stated that he was not aware that the limestone is no longer at the site and further that he has been told that the limestone was removed by Mr. Ronnie Gonsoulin.

Upon request by Councilman Thomas J. Landry, Mr. Karl Vincent, Chairman of the Acadiana Fairgrounds Commission, addressed the Council and advised that the Commission has an agreement with Ronnie Gonsoulin that in exchange for agricultural royalties on a twelve acre tract of property, Mr. Gonsoulin would provide laser leveling and dirt work to the Commission. Mr. Gonsoulin is now in the process of laser leveling the property and allegedly removed approximately two truck loads of limestone (mixed with matting material) from the property in order to complete the laser leveling work.

Upon questioning by the Vice-Chairman, Mr. Vincent and Parish President Ernest Freyou both said that they were not aware of any specific permission granted to Mr. Gonsoulin to remove the limestone from the site. It was suggested that this item be referred to the District Attorney's Office for investigation to determine what action is required.

An Ordinance authorizing the levy of the following millages on all property subject to taxation for the year 2011: (a) General Parish Millage (formerly known as the General Alimony Millage), in the rural areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 3.43 mills; (b) Exempted Municipalities Millage (formerly known as the Criminal Tax Millage), in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 1.71 mills; (c) Courthouse and Jail Millage, in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 0.80 mills; (d) Fire Protection District No. 1 Millage, for the rural areas only, at a rate of 6.50 mills; (e) Public Buildings Maintenance Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.53 mills; (f) Drainage Facilities Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 3.11 mills; (g) Health Unit Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 1.50 mills; (h) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.58 mills; (i) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, to be used to pay outstanding debt for the Parish Library System, at a rate of 0.45 mills.
