The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. Roger Duncan, its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL:

1. Mr. Karl Vincent, representing the Acadiana Fairgrounds Commission, to address the Council to discuss agricultural leases and a lease with Ronnie Gonsoulin.

Mr. Vincent explained that the Fairgrounds had negotiated a ten year lease, "no rent income", in exchange for \$22,500 worth of dirt work with Mr. Gonsoulin, which Mr. Gonsoulin had completed said dirt work five years into the lease. Later when the aeration pits were proposed, Mr. Gonsoulin was compensated for his loss of crops. After the aeration pits project ceased to continue, it was requested that Mr. Gonsoulin turtle back the property in order that the Commission could cut the grass on the property. Eventually, the property was put back into farmland. Mr. Vincent stated that Mr. Gonsoulin should be compensated for the additional work performed by him to level the property so that it could be maintained properly.

Discuss and consider action regarding a Summary Appraisal Report for property located at 210 Iberia Street, which market value is appraised at \$210,000.

Mr. Bernard E. Broussard stated that The Neon Company has completed the Summary Appraisal Report for property located at 210 Iberia Street, indicating a market value of \$210,000. Mr. Broussard explained that Dr. Babineaux would like to continue using the property until his new office building is completed, which is expected to be in September 2012. Mr. Broussard stated that Dr. Babineaux would lease the property, similar to the leasing of the Breau Building, with all payments being deducted from the purchase price.

Dr. Todd Babineaux then address the Council and stated that he would accept \$200,000 for the property, with the option to lease same as stated by Mr. Broussard.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-01-4369

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY OF BRIAN AND COLETTE PROVOST LOCATED AT 2701 LAKE DAUTERIVE ROAD FROM AGRICULTURAL (A-1) TO INDUSTRIAL (I-1), LOCATED IN DISTRICT 9, ALL AS RECOMMENDED BY THE IBERIA PARISH REGIONAL PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

- SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2009-02-4009, adopted February 25, 2009, established Zoning Regulations for rural Iberia Parish and is recorded in the Official Records of Iberia Parish at COB 1430, Page 65.
- SECTION 2. At that time the Zoning Ordinance and Map was adopted the area shown on the attached map and described above was zoned Agricultural (A-1) even though the site was in use as "Pro-Drive Shallow Water Outboards" which is an industrial use.
- SECTION 3. In as much as the site is utilized commercially and is zoned agriculturally, the site is considered non-conforming and cannot be expanded even though it may continue to operate.
- SECTION 4. The property owners intend to expand the facility in the future which will require a reclassification from Agricultural (A-1) to Industrial (I-1) to facilitate their projected growth.
- SECTION 5. Proper notice was provided to all affected property owners and to the general public in accordance with all established procedures.
- SECTION 6. The Iberia Parish Regional Zoning Commission did conduct a public hearing and accepted all public input, and, after due deliberation amongst themselves, did make a motion to recommend reclassification from Agricultural (A-1) to Industrial (I-1) for the reasons expressed in the attached Staff Report, which was seconded; the vote was unanimous.
- SECTION 7. The Iberia Parish Council after accepting all public input, deliberation on their part, and proper motion and second did approve the reclassification request of Brian and Colette Provost from Agricultural (A-1) to Industrial (I-1).

WHEREAS, the Iberia Parish Council is requesting that the District Attorney's Office provide recommendations on the employment of Special Labor Legal Counsel to assist with the review of Parish Personnel Policies and Procedures in relation to the status of Parish employees; and
