AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE LEVY OF THE FOLLOWING MILLAGES ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2012: (A) GENERAL PARISH MILLAGE (FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE GENERAL ALIMONY MILLAGE), IN THE RURAL AREAS OF THE PARISH ONLY, AT A RATE OF 3.43 MILLS; (B) EXEMPTED MUNICIPALITIES MILLAGE (FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE CRIMINAL TAX MILLAGE), IN THE INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE PARISH ONLY, AT A RATE OF 1.71 MILLS; (C) COURTHOUSE AND JAIL MILLAGE, IN THE INCORPORATED AREAS OF THE PARISH ONLY, AT A RATE OF 0.80 MILLS; (D) FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 1 MILLAGE, FOR THE RURAL AREAS ONLY, AT A RATE OF 6.50 MILLS; (E) PUBLIC BUILDINGS MAINTENANCE MILLAGE, FOR PARISHWIDE PROPERTY, AT A RATE OF 4.53 MILLS; (F) DRAINAGE FACILITIES MILLAGE, FOR PARISHWIDE PROPERTY, AT A RATE OF 3.11 MILLS; (G) HEALTH UNIT MILLAGE, FOR PARISHWIDE PROPERTY, AT A RATE OF 1.50 MILLS; (H) PARISH LIBRARY MILLAGE, FOR PARISHWIDE PROPERTY, AT A RATE OF 4.58 MILLS; (I) PARISH LIBRARY MILLAGE, FOR PARISHWIDE PROPERTY, TO BE USED TO PAY OUTSTANDING DEBT FOR THE PARISH LIBRARY SYSTEM, AT A RATE OF 0.45 MILLS.

THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the following millages are hereby levied on the 2013 tax roll on all property subject to taxation by the Iberia Parish Government:

- (a) General Parish Millage (formerly known as the General Alimony Millage), in the rural areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 3.43 mills;
- (b) Exempted Municipalities Millage (formerly known as the Criminal Tax Millage), in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 1.71 mills;
- (c) Courthouse and Jail Millage, in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 0.80 mills;
- (d) Fire Protection District No. 1 Millage, for the rural areas only, at a rate of 6.50 mills;
- (e) Public Buildings Maintenance Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.53 mills;
- (f) Drainage Facilities Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 3.11 mills;
- (g) Health Unit Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 1.50 mills;
- (h) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.58 mills;
- (i) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, to be used to pay outstanding debt for the Parish Library System, at a rate of 0.45 mills.

SECTION 2. That the proper administrative officials of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, be, and they are, hereby empowered, authorized, and directed to spread said taxes, as hereinabove set forth, upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2012, and to make the collection of the taxes imposed for, and on behalf of, the taxing authority, according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE INVESTIGATION PROCESS UNDER SECTION 2-08 OF THE CHARTER, INCLUDING AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENAS, TAKING SWORN TESTIMONY OF WITNESSES, AND/OR REQUIRING THE PRODUCTION OF EVIDENCE AND FURTHER INCLUDING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A BAILIFF, COURT REPORTER, AND ANY OTHER PERSONS FOR THE COMPLETION OF SAID INVESTIGATION.

WHEREAS, the Iberia Parish Council has adopted Resolution No. 2012-158, for the purpose of investigating the Parish President's Office regarding issues raised by the receipt of a letter from the Louisiana Attorney General, dated April 16, 2012, which letter was issued in response to a "complaint" issued by the Parish President regarding allegations against the 16th Judicial District Attorney's Office, in order to determine if further investigation is warranted by outside agencies.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to consider the appropriation of funds for court reporter services, security and other related services for the purposes of conducting the investigation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby invoke Section 2-08 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter, entitled "Investigation." for the purpose of investigating the Parish President's Office regarding issues raised by the receipt of a letter from the Louisiana Attorney General, dated April 16, 2012, which letter was issued in response to a "complaint" issued by the Parish President regarding allegations against the 16th Judicial District Attorney's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Attorney General letter advises that it is not illegal or improper for the Parish to choose to reimburse the District Attorney's Office for the cost of health insurance benefits, which has been a practice of Iberia Parish Government since 1973 and the Iberia Parish Council directs that said invoices shall continue to be reimbursed as budgeted in the 2012 budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Attorney General letter advises that investigation of the "complaint's" allegations that the District Attorney's Office coerced citizens to vote for a particular candidate, provided information that, when questioned, no one admitted that they were forced, threatened, intimidated or coerced to support a particular candidate and further that there is absolutely no evidence that any type of criminal activity took place on the part of the District Attorney or any members of his staff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby authorize an investigation into the careless and unsubstantiated allegations submitted through sworn affidavits submitted with said "complaint" with the intent to cause an investigation of, or other action to be taken as a result, in order to determine if further investigation is warranted by outside agencies.

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-189

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF WILDLIFE AND FISHERIES TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF THE BAYOU TECHE TO DETERMINE IF IT CAN BE INCLUDED IN THE STATE'S HISTORIC AND SCENIC RIVERS SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, Bayou Teche is an 135 mile long waterway of great cultural and historic significance in south central Louisiana which was the main course of the Mississippi River when it developed a delta about 2,800 to 4,500 years ago; and

WHEREAS, Bayou Teche begins in Port Barre where it draws water from Bayou Courtableau and then flows southward to meet the Lower Atchafalaya River near Morgan City, running through St. Landry, St. Martin, Iberia and St. Mary parishes; and

WHEREAS, Bayou Teche was a primary waterway that brought exiled Acadians from present day Nova Scotia, was a focus of conflict during the American Civil War and up until construction of the levees along the Atchafalaya River in the 1930's served as an important route of commerce in southeast Louisiana; and

WHEREAS, Bayou Teche was a vital link between thriving communities of south central Louisiana and the Gulf of Mexico, a link that was used by everyone from Native Americans and French explorers to nineteenth century steamboat captains and twentieth century loggers and fishermen and was a major waterway through much of south central Louisiana's history; and

WHEREAS, the name "Teche" is a Chitimacha Indian word meaning "snake", related to the bayou's twists and turns resembling a snake's movement; and

WHEREAS, inclusion in the Louisiana Historic and Scenic Rivers system would greatly increase recognition of Bayou Teche for its historic and cultural value and would help to increase recreation and tourism on the Bayou and in communities along the Bayou.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby urge and request the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to conduct a study of the Bayou Teche to determine if it can be included in the Louisiana Historic and Scenic Rivers System.
