The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Ms. Maggie F. Daniels, its Vice-Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL:

1. Persons filling applications of interest to Parish Boards/Commissions to address the Council to introduce themselves.

The following applicants introduced themselves to the Council:
(a) Ms. Roxy Blanton, Library Board, (b) Ms. Greta Green, Spanish Lake Game and Fishing Preserve Commission and (c) Mr. Randy Gonsoulin, Regional Planning Commission.

2. Mr. Mike Lapeyrouse and Ms. Jeanne Clement, representing Lapeyrouse Motors, request to address the Council regarding a recent bid process for a vehicle for the Emergency Management Department.

Councilman David Ditch recommended the Council remove the three (3) minute limit for Persons to Address policy to allow the representatives of Lapeyrouse Motors to present information regarding recent bids obtained for vehicles by the Homeland Security Office and by Sewerage District No. 1.

Councilman Bernard E. Broussard entered the meeting at 6:20 P.M.

Mr. Lapeyrouse questioned the Parish's issuance of bids to the next highest bidder for the vehicle for the Homeland Security Office, at an cost of \$3,653 more than the lowest bid.

Assistant District Attorney, Dean Wattigny explained that Requests for Proposals were issued and formal bids were not taken for this particular vehicle. He also explained that according to Mr. Prescott Marshall several of the specifications for the vehicle were not available, such as a tow hook, etc. Mr. Wattigny also stated that Sewer District No. 1 purchased a larger truck at less money through the State contract, after receipt of proposals for the original vehicle.

Councilman Bernard E. Broussard resumed as Chairman.

Councilwoman Aquicline Rener-Arnold requested that the Parish make every effort to do business with local businesses, especially in the Jeanerette area.

Mr. Mike Lapeyrouse requested that the Council consider the implementation of procedures and use of local dealerships for the purchase of vehicles.

Chairman Bernard E. Broussard then requested that Mr. Prescott Marshall and Mr. Joe Gonzalez both be in attendance at the next meeting to respond to questions regarding these matters.

A motion was made by Mr. Curtis Boudoin, seconded by Ms. Aquicline Rener-Arnold, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby recess its Regular Session and convene as a Public Hearing to obtain public comments regarding Ordinances and Resolutions being considered for final adoption.

Mr. Pat Viator spoke in opposition to Resolution Summary No. 216.

Parish President Errol "Romo" Romero stated that there are regulations established in the Personnel Policy Manual and further that the Iberia Parish Council can not tell him what to do ...

Reference was made to Section 4-04 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter, Administrative Reorganization, which can be accomplished by the President with adoption of a Resolution of the Council or by the Council directing the Administration's reorganization.

Mr. Troy Comeaux questioned whether the employee in the position of Drainage Maintenance Superintendent also serves as the "official" Iberia Parish Government spokesperson, when the Council has not authorized such a position.

Parish President Romero stated that this employee serves as his "Girl Friday", including duties as spokesperson.

Mr. Troy Comeaux stated that he feels that there is a need for Council approval of a job description for this particular position and when it was proposed to the Council at a previous meeting, the vote to create the position failed.

Mr. David Ditch questioned the fund paying this position and was advised that this fund has revenue derived from a drainage maintenance property millage and can only be used for drainage purposes.

Also expressing opinions regarding this proposal was Mr. Pat

Following some discussion, Mr. Pat Viator challenged the Council Chairman and Parish President to talk about problems. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY OF ANDREA KILCHRIST LOCATED AT 2414 EAST HWY. 90 FROM AGRICULTURAL (A-1) TO SECTION A INDUSTRIAL (I-1) AND SECTION B COMMERCIAL (C-2), ALL AS APPROVED BY THE PERMITS, PLANNING AND ZONING DEPARTMENT.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2009-02-4009, adopted February 25, 2009, established Zoning Regulations for rural Iberia Parish and is recorded in the Official Records of Iberia Parish at COB 1430, Page 65.

SECTION 2. The Department of Permitting, Planning, and Zoning received a request to reclassify the property of Andrea Kilchrist located at 2414 East Highway 90 for thirty-two (32) acres of property off of Hwy. 90 East, with nine (9) acres for the purposes of "constructing an aggregate and concrete recycling facility" that deals with hardened-up materials and approximately twenty-three (23) acres for the purpose of Commercial (C-2) development.

SECTION 3. The Iberia Parish Zoning Commission conducted a public hearing on March 15, 2012, and after accepting all public input, deliberation on their part, and proper motion and second did recommend approval of the reclassification request from Agricultural (A-1) Section A to Industrial (I-1) and Section B to Commercial (C-2) as shown upon a current survey completed by Mr. Paul Fell, dated April 24, 2012.

SECTION 4. That the property of Andrea Kilchrist located at 2414 East Hwy. 90 is hereby reclassified from Agricultural (A-1) Section A to Industrial (I-1) and Section B to Commercial (C-2).

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPILED ORDINANCES OF IBERIA PARISH TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR PERSONS REFUSING TO OBEY THE LAWFUL ORDER OF THE COUNCIL, ALL IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2-08. INVESTIGATIONS OF THE IBERIA PARISH HOME RULE CHARTER.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the Compiled Ordinances of Iberia Parish is hereby amended as follows:

Investigation by Iberia Parish Council.

(a) In accordance with Section 2-08. Investigation of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter, the Iberia Parish Council may make investigations into the affairs of the Parish Government and the related conduct of any Parish official, officer, employee, department, office, or agency and for this purpose subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, take testimony, and require the production of evidence.

(b) Any person who fails or refuses to obey any lawful order of the Council shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, after conviction, shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned in the parish jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE IBERIA PARISH COMPILED ORDINANCES TO REQUIRE THAT ANY CULVERTS TO BE INSTALLED WITHIN ANY PUBLIC DRAINAGE DITCHES SHALL PROVIDE FOR A MINIMUM CULVERT SIZE TO PROVIDE FOR A FLOW CAPACITY PROVIDED BY 18" CULVERTS.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the Iberia Parish Compiled Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

Minimum Size for Culverts installed in Public Drainage Ditches.

The Public Works Department shall grant permission and authority to construct culvert installation on roadside and public ditches for any public drainage ditches after written application. Upon approval by the Public Works Department, the property owner shall provide culvert installation as follows:

Subsurface drainage will be designed to accommodate a five (5) year recurrent storm interval Roughness Coefficients and Manning's Formula will be utilized. A rational method for design will be used ($Q=C.I.A.$). For additional information, see Chapter V of the U.S. Bureau of Public Roads Publication "Design Charts for Open Channel Flows, Hydraulic Design Series No. 3".

The maximum grade that will be used will produce a velocity of eight (8') feet per second.

The minimum grade that will be used will produce a velocity of three (3') feet per second. Minimum size pipe of eighteen (18") inches will be utilized.

The maximum length of pipe between catch basins and/or manholes will be:

<u>Pipe Size (Inches)</u>	<u>Maximum Length (Feet)</u>
18	300
24 and 36	400
42 and larger	600

A minimum time of five (5") inches will be for overland flow based on a minimum duration of five (5) minutes.

The Public Works Department shall grant permission and authority to construct culvert installation on roadside and public ditches for any public drainage ditches.

The installation of any culverts on roadside and public ditches for any public drainage ditches shall provide for a minimum culvert size to provide for a flow capacity provided by 18" culverts.

Penalty. It shall be the responsibility of the owner to comply with these regulations and should the owner fail to follow said regulations, the Iberia Parish Public Works Department is authorized to remove any and/or all culvert installation and the owner forfeits any and/or all materials associated with said installation.

SECTION 2. That the Public Works Department is hereby authorized to enact this requirement.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.
