

**MINUTES OF THE IBERIA PARISH REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING CONDUCTED
ON THURSDAY, APRIL 10, 2014 AT 5:30 PM IN THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL CHAMBERS LOCATED
AT 300 IBERIA STREET, NEW IBERIA, LOUISIANA 70560**

CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Dana Dugas determined there was a quorum and called the Meeting to Order.

MEMBERS PRESENT: David Fangué, Lanie Borel, Dana Dugas, Nathaniel Mitchell, Butch Bourgeois

MEMBERS ABSENT: Jane Braud, Ronald Fremin and Perry Judice

OTHERS PRESENT: John R. Raines, Julie Armentor

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: David Fangué made a Motion to approve the February 27, 2014 Minutes which was seconded by Nathaniel Mitchell; the vote was unanimous.

ABANDONMENT REQUEST: Marshall Moneaux – Abandonment of portion of Gaspard Road. John Raines explained the location of Gaspard Road and the request of Mr. Moneaux. Mr. Moneaux said he was asking to abandon the rear portion of the right-of-way because trash was being thrown in the ditch, the farmer did not need Gaspard Road for access to the adjoining farmland, and to keep four wheelers off the property.

Chairman Dugas opened the Public Hearing and requested input; there being none, closed the Public Hearing and requested direction from the Commission.

Nathaniel Mitchell made a Motion to approve the abandonment request conditional upon approval from Public Works which was seconded by David Fangué; the vote was unanimous.

DEVELOPMENT REVIEW: Department of Permitting, Planning and Zoning – Adoption of Family Partition Regulations. John Raines requested no action at this time as the proposal is under scrutiny by the Legal Department.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Department of Permitting, Planning and Zoning – Adoption of Membership Rules and Terms. John Raines explained that correspondence had been sent to Mayor Broussard of Delcambre requesting a replacement for Barbara Laviolette. He elaborated that the correspondence advised Mayor Broussard that if he failed to provide a replacement within ten (10) days, the Iberia Parish Councilman for the Delcambre area, Marty Trahan, would be requested to provide a replacement. He further indicated that he was going to propose an amendment that if an existing member of the Commission' term expires, and, no replacement can be found within sixty (60), and if the previous Commissioner wishes to serve again, the Iberia Parish Council can reappoint him/her to the Commission for another term.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business, Chairman Dugas requested a Motion to adjourn which was made by Lanie Borel, seconded by David Fangué; the vote was unanimous.
