AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERSONNEL POLICY MANUAL FOR ALL BRANCHES OF IBERIA PARISH GOVERNMENT TO REFLECT THAT NEPOTISM SHALL BE REFLECTED AS CURRENTLY DEFINED BY THE LA. CODE OF GOVERNMENTAL ETHICS.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the Iberia Parish Council has adopted Personnel Policy Manuals for several of its branches and/or agencies.

SECTION 2. That all branches and/or agencies currently utilizing an Iberia Parish Government Personnel Policy Manual is hereby amended to reflect that nepotism shall be reflected as currently defined by the La. Code of Governmental Ethics.

SECTION 3. That the Director of Human Resources is hereby charged with ensuring that all branches and/or agencies' Personnel Policy Manuals reflect the current definition of nepotism as defined by the La. Code of Governmental Ethics.

SECTION 4. That the Director of Human Resources is hereby authorized to provide updates to the definition of nepotism as updated by the La. Code of Governmental Ethics and provide written documentation of same to the Chairman of the Council of said notification.

A RESOLUTION AMENDING VARIOUS RESOLUTIONS REGARDING FUNDING APPROPRIATED FOR THE CAJUN RVERA PROJECT TO CLARIFY THAT THOSE RESOLUTIONS APPROPRIATING FUNDING FROM THE GENERAL AND/OR PUBLIC BUILDINGS MAINTENANCE FUNDS SHALL BE CONSIDERED LOANS AND ARE TO BE REPAYED BY THE CAJUN RVERA FROM FUTURE REVENUES AND THOSE RESOLUTIONS APPROPRIATING FUNDING FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 SHALL BE CONSIDERED GRANTS AND ARE NOT TO BE REPAYED BY THE CAJUN RVERA.

WHEREAS, various Resolutions approved appropriated funding from the General and/or the Public Buildings Maintenance Fund Budgets for the Cajun RVerA Project in the past; and

WHEREAS, some of these Resolutions provide that said funding appropriated will be considered a transfer and some Resolution are considered a loan, while some of the Resolutions to not provide information regarding whether this fund appropriated was a transfer or loan; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide clarification on whether the following Resolutions are to be considered as a transfer or a loan:

1. Resolution No. 2013-255, which appropriated a total of \$304,000 (\$144,000 for the Splash Pad and road striping; \$160,000 Pool House Construction);
2. Resolution No. 2013-422, which appropriated \$25,000 for dirt removal;
3. Resolution No. 2013-423, which appropriated \$83,000 for additional asphalt; and
4. Resolution No. 2014-72, which appropriated \$145,150 for start up costs.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires the adoption of the Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRM), which were adopted by Ordinance No. 2011-11-4320, on November 2, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Emile Verret Bridget over Channel M-26 (Tete Bayou) was completed in 2008 and provided improvements to the drainage of water within the adjacent areas; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to include this change on the FIRM panels to take into consideration the improvements made as a result of the completion of the Emile Verret Bridge over Channel M-26 (Tete Bayou); and

WHEREAS, there have been various other drainage improvements projects throughout rural Iberia Parish, including the cleaning of the Tete Bayou Drainage Project, which may affect the FIRM maps for various residential and commercial areas of the Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Council to proceed with the development and issuance of Requests for Qualifications for various engineering firms interested in providing an updated rural map of various drainage improvements to be used with FEMA when requesting that they revisit and reconsider various FIRM panels for the Parish; and

WHEREAS, it is requested that the Administration obtain engineering proposals for this matter and report to the Public Health and Safety Committee at its meeting to be held on Wednesday, July 16, 2014 for further direction by the Council.

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE FOLLOWING CHANNEL AS WATERSHED CHANNELS IN IBERIA PARISH AS FOLLOWS: (A) CHANNEL L-2A-12, WITH A 35' WIDTH ON EACH SIDE, LOCATED IN DISTRICT 10, TO ALLOW FOR A TEMPORARY EASEMENT.

WHEREAS, that, in accordance with Chapter 20, Section 20-7, Easement for Drainage Canal, Levee, and Appurtenances, the following channels shall be established as part of the Watershed Program in Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, that witnesseth for and in consideration of the benefits and improvements to Grantors in adjoining lands derived from the operation and maintenance of the drainage project hereafter mentioned, Grantor hereby acknowledges and does hereby grant and convey unto the Parish of Iberia, his successors and assigns, the right, liberty, and authority to enter upon and to construct, operate, and maintain a drainage canal, levee, and appurtenances in, over, and upon the following channels, situated in the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby establish watershed channels in Iberia Parish, as follows:

- (a) Channel L-2A-12, located in Section 11, R7E, T13S, for a 35' width on each side; channel is frm the east side of Freyou Road from Channel L-2A-2 westerly through Wildwood Subdivision to Channel L-2A; located in District 10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this easement is a TEMPORARY easement and is not a permanent easement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Parish President is hereby authorized by virtue of this Resolution to sign said Easements for Drainage Canals, Levees, and Appurtenances.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this easement shall be recorded in the Official Records of Iberia Parish.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.

SUMMARY NO. 4595 (Introduced by Clerk of the Council)

An Ordinance authorizing the levy of millages for the year 2014, as follows: (a) General Parish Millage (formerly known as the General Alimony Millage), in the rural areas of the Parish only, at the rate of 3.43 mills; (b) Exempted Municipalities Millage (formerly known as the Criminal Tax Millage), in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 1.71 mills; (c) Courthouse and Jail Millage, in the incorporated areas of the Parish only, at a rate of 0.76 mills; (d) Fire Protection District No. 1 Millage, for the rural areas only, at a rate of 6.5 mills; (e) Public Buildings Maintenance Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.38 mills; (f) Drainage Facilities Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 3.01 mills; (g) Health Unit Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 1.45 mills; (h) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, at a rate of 4.43 mills; and (i) Parish Library Millage, for parishwide property, to be used to pay outstanding debt for the Parish Library System, at a rate of 0.45 mills, authorized the levying of various millages for the year 2014, in order to adjust the millage rates.

A motion was made by Ms. Aquicline Rener-Arnold, seconded by Mr. Marty Trahan, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby adjourn.
