## PERSONS TO ADDRESS THE COUNCIL:

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2014-359, WHICH RESOLUTION AMENDS THE 2014 ROYALTY FUND BUDGET IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$4,000,000 TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR INITIAL COSTS OF BRIDGE REPAIRS (WHICH ARE TO BE FUNDED THROUGH A FUTURE BOND ISSUE) IN ORDER THAT SAID BRIDGE REPAIRS MAY PROCEED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, WITH SUCH COSTS TO BE REIMBURSED TO THE ROYALTY FUND IMMEDIATELY UPON THE RECEIPT OF REVENUES FROM SAID BOND ISSUE, AND FURTHER TO BE FUNDED FROM THE FUND BALANCE - PREVIOUS YEARS, IN ORDER TO CHANGE THE AMOUNT TO AN AMOUNT UP TO \$25,000 FOR SAID INITIAL COSTS, AND FURTHER RETURNING THE REMAINING BALANCE OF \$3,975,000 TO THE ROYALTY FUND BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2014-359, adopted October 22, 2014, which amended the 2014 Royalty Fund Budget in an amount up to \$4,000,000 to provide funding for initial costs of bridge replacements and/or repairs (which are to be funded through a future bond issue) in order that said bridge replacements and/or repairs may proceed as soon as possible, with such costs to be reimbursed to the Royalty Fund immediately upon the receipt of revenues from said bond issue, and further to be funded from the Fund Balance - Previous Years, and further that any proposed repairs are to be recommended to the Council by the Administration and/or Public Works Department for approval by the Parish Council prior to any repair work commencing on said bridge; and

WHEREAS, there has been a request to rescind this Resolution at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Iberia Parish Council has discussed the proposed rescinding of the Ordinance and is choosing to amend the amount from \$4,000,000 to \$25,000 in lieu of rescinding said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Council does hereby amend Resolution No. 2014-359, adopted October 22, 2014, which amended the 2014 Royalty Fund Budget in an amount up to \$4,000,000 to provide funding for initial costs of bridge replacements and/or repairs (which are to be funded through a future bond issue) in order that said bridge replacements and/or repairs may proceed as soon as possible, with such costs to be reimbursed to the Royalty Fund immediately upon the receipt of revenues from said bond issue, with said funding to be funded from the Fund Balance - Previous Years, and which required that any proposed repairs are to be recommended to the Council by the Administration and/or Public Works Department for approval by the Parish Council prior to any repair work commencing on said bridge, in order to change the amount to an amount up to \$25,000 for said initial costs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the remaining balance of \$3,975,000 shall be returned to the Royalty Fund Budget as previously budgeted within said budget.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said funding shall be provided for the initial costs of bridge repairs (which are to be funded through a future bond issue) in order that said bridge repairs may proceed as soon as possible and that this funding shall be reimbursed to the Royalty Fund Budget immediately upon the receipt of revenues from the issuance of bonds for this purpose.
