

PROCEEDINGS FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SEWERAGE DISTRICT No. 1 OF IBERIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, JULY 29, 2025.

The Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish, Louisiana, met in Regular Session at the Iberia Parish Sewerage District No. 1 office, 2617 Northside Road on Tuesday, July 29, 2025, at four o'clock p.m.

Gage Guidry called the meeting to order with the following members present: Gage Guidry, Eddie Chretien, William Labauve, and Sy Bodin.

Also, present were Chandler Staples, Staples Engineering, Darius Colar, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, and Scott Landry, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC.

It was moved by Chretien, seconded by Labauve, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby approve the minutes taken at the Regular Meeting held on June 24, 2025.

A report was given by Scott Landry of Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, on the operation and maintenance of Plant 3 for the month of July 2025. Preventative maintenance was performed in several areas of the plant. A new butterfly valve was added to the waste activated sludge line for better flow control. Eighty-two thousand five hundred (82,500) gallons of sludge have been wasted from June 18 to July 28, 2025.

A report from Darius Colar with Statewide Electrical Services, LLC was reviewed for the month of July 2025 for the operation and maintenance of the District's field. All work for the month was primarily routine operation and maintenance. A new pump was installed at 1706 Troy Road. A force main was repaired at US Frame. We have been experiencing an extreme influx of wipes at the Arc/677 lift station. The vacuum truck was used at Arc lift station several times and Belair lift station.

A report from Staples Engineering: Highway 90 project notice to proceed has been issued to Southern Constructors. The final walk through for First Solar is scheduled for July 31, 2025.

The Director gave his report. We are in the process of repairing gates at six stations. FY2026 budget preparations are underway. The District is working to procure twenty new SCADA systems for various stations.

Having no other business, it was moved by Chretien, seconded by Bodin, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby adjourn.
