[IBERIA PARISH, LA – November 17, 2025] **Iberia Parish President M. Larry Richard** advises motorists beginning on Wednesday, November 19, 2025, Glenn Lege Construction, LLC will start road improvements on the following roads in Iberia Parish.

The following roads will receive asphalt patching in advance of an asphalt overlay.

- General Chappuis St – between General Patton St and the Cul-de-sac
- General Collins St - between the drainage canal south of General Collins St and the Cul-de-Sac

The following roads will have sample material removed from each road for testing. Once the testing data is received these streets will be reconstructed.

- General Patton St – between Captain Cade Rd and the Cul-de-sac
- General Middleton St – between General Patton St and the Cul-de-sac
- General Collins St – between General Patton St and the Cul-de-sac
- General Bradley St – between General Middleton St and the canal south of General Collins St.

Working Time – 7:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday and possibly on Saturday.

This construction is anticipated to last approximately 2 weeks weather permitting. The public will be re-notified before the roads are to be reconstructed and overlaid. During construction it may be necessary at times to limit access to the construction area with road closures and traffic detours around the work area. Road closure signs, barricades and detour signs will be in place to warn and direct traffic. Residents and drivers should anticipate time delays. The roads at times will have loose gravel and oil on the roadway.

Iberia Parish Government appreciates your patience during construction. If possible, please avoid the construction areas. Drive with caution and be on the lookout for work crews and their equipment. Area residents should exercise caution when driving, walking, or biking near an active construction zone.
