

PROCEEDINGS FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SEWERAGE DISTRICT No. 1 OF IBERIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 22, 2025.

The Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish, Louisiana, met in Regular Session at the Iberia Parish Sewerage District No. 1 office, 2617 Northside Road on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, at four o'clock p.m.

Kasey Thibodeaux called the meeting to order with the following members present: Kasey Thibodeaux, Gage Guidry, Eddie Chretien, William Labauve, and Sy Bodin.

Also, present were Chandler Staples, Staples Engineering, Barry Segura, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, and Scott Landry, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC.

It was moved by Guidry, seconded by Chretien, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby approve the minutes taken at the Regular Meeting held on March 25, 2025.

This motion having been submitted to a vote; the vote thereon was as follows:

A report was given by Barry Segura of Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, on the operation and maintenance of Plant 3 for the month of April 2025. Preventative maintenance was performed in several areas of the plant. He reported that all has been routine for the most part and all major components of the daily operations and maintenance are functioning properly. Aerator #3 is back online and a new effluent flow meter has been installed. One hundred five thousand, six hundred (105,600) gallons of sludge have been wasted from March 21 to April 21, 2025.

A report from Barry Segura with Statewide Electrical Services, LLC was reviewed for the month of April 2025 for the operation and maintenance of the District's field. All work for the month was primarily routine operation and maintenance. Manholes in the Weeks Island Road area are being repaired to help mitigate groundwater intrusion. New pumps were put in at Chart and E. Old Spanish Trail. Repaired the station located at LA Cat – Port of Iberia. West End and Penny Wise were pumped out and the contact chambers were cleaned.

A report from Staples Engineering: The upgrades to Main Station should be complete by the end of May. The District is still in the process of obtaining right of ways for the Hwy 90 Sewer Improvement Project.

The Director gave his report. Point repairs in the Weeks Island area have continued as well as five manholes being regouted and repaired in an effort to reduce rain and groundwater infiltration. The Iberia Parish Council has approved and additional \$300k for the UL project. The Subdivision Project under the Water Sector Grant bid opening is scheduled for April 30, 2025.

It was moved by Guidry and seconded by Chretien that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby accept the 2024 MWPP (Municipal Water Pollution Prevention) for Plant 3.
