SUMMARY NO. 109 (Introduced by Brian P. Napier, District 11) A Resolution amending the 2023 Public Library Fund Budget in the amount of \$500,000 for roof repairs at the Main Library Branch, all to be funded from the Fund Balance - Previous Years.
