The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. Warren P. Gachassin, Jr., its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Brian P. Napier congratulated Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. and his daughter, Aline Gachassin for hosting a very successful event, "Aline's Amazing Lemonade Stand" at his home on Saturday, April 13, 2024 to benefit Angel Paws Adoption Center.
2. Councilman James P. Trahan also congratulated Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. for hosting a successful event for the benefit of Angel Paws Adoption Center and thanked him for allowing him to be a part of the event in which he cooked jambalaya.
3. Councilman James P. Trahan announced that Festival Live Oaks will be held at New Iberia City Park on Saturday, April 27, 2024. There will be live music, crafts and vendor booths with a Barbeque Cookoff for adults and juniors.
4. Councilman Thomas "Tommy" Pollard, Sr. announced that the Spanish Festival was held last weekend. There was live music and lots of food.
5. Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. wished Legal Counsel Ian Alpha a "Happy Birthday" and thanked him for a everything he does for Iberia Parish.
6. Councilman Brian P. Napier advised attendees that the Iberia Parish Council is working diligently with Legal Counsel as well as Permit, Planning and Zoning to develop a Solar Farm Ordinance in an effort to protect community members and keep the community safe. He assured everyone that no action will be taken until thorough consideration is taken by Iberia Parish Council. He also assured everyone that the community will be given a chance to state their opinions and review the Ordinance. He further advised attendees that Resolution No. 2024-23 was issued for a six-month moratorium which will expire on August 26, 2024.
7. Councilman Natalie Broussard thanked attendees for being present at the meeting and being concerned citizens of Iberia Parish. She also assured attendees that Iberia Parish Council will ensure the safety of community members.
7. Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. announced that the next Iberia Parish Council Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 8, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Parish President M. Larry Richard reminded everyone that a Special Election will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024 for the 10-Year Dedicated Road Tax of 0.75% which will be used for the purpose of constructing, improving and maintaining roads and streets in unincorporated areas of Iberia Parish.
2. President Richard also reminded everyone that the Special Election consists of Millage Renewal Propositions for the Health Unit, Library, Public Buildings and Drainage.
3. President Richard informed the Council that Town Hall Meetings have been held in Loreauville, Lydia, Coteau, Grand Marais, and Camp Knighton to discuss the proposed millages and road tax and have been very successful in educating the community.
4. President Richard announced that Household Waste Day will be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. till 12:00 p.m. at the Main Courthouse Building rear parking lot.
5. President Richard announced that Acadiana Regional Airport Director Maurice "Moe" Songy traveled to Washington, DC and met with Senator Bill Cassidy, Senator John Kennedy, Representative Garret Graves and Representative Clay Higgins to discuss federal grant funding for the Acadiana Regional Airport to build an international cargo facility.

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6. President Richard announced that the Jefferson Island Road and Sidewalk Pre-Construction Meeting was held on April 12, 2024 with the contract being awarded to Triumph Construction. The project will begin at the Cleco Substation and follow through Dillard Street. The Notice to Proceed will be issued on May 28, 2024 and is expected to be completed in August of 2024.
7. President Richard announced that the former Coteau Library was advertised as surplus property. A bid was received and the Purchase Agreement is expected to be signed this week for the building to be removed within 30 days.
8. President Richard advised that construction continues at Jefferson Canal South. On Monday, April 15, 2024, the installation of box culverts began with this phase of the project being completed. The next phase will consist of forming and pouring concrete head walls, back stalling and installing flapper gates. This project will protect many homes and property in Iberia Parish from flooding and is expected to be completed in September of 2024.
9. President Richard also reminded everyone to visit the new website for Iberia Parish Government which can be viewed at www.iberiaparishgovernment.com.
