The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. Chad Maturin, its Vice-Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Caymen Crappell announced the 73<sup>rd</sup> Delcambre Shrimp Festival will be held on Wednesday, August 13, 2025 thru Sunday, August 17, 2025 in Delcambre, Louisiana. Everyone is invited to attend.
2. Councilman Scott Ransonet requested that a video regarding the Federal Reserve be played for viewing by the Iberia Parish Council Members.
3. Councilman Francis "Tommy" Pollard, Sr. reminded everyone that school has reopened in Iberia Parish and asked everyone to please pay attention to children in school zones and bus stops.
4. Councilman Francis "Tommy" Pollard, Sr. also reminded everyone that tractors are also on the roads for sugarcane planting and asked everyone to please be mindful and help keep our farmers safe.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Chief Operating Officer Michael Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that 12 individuals participated in the Litter Abatement Program on Saturday, July 26, 2025 and Saturday, August 9, 2025. A total of 157 bags of trash and other items were collected in the areas of Jasper Road, Old LA. 25, L. Theriot Road, Blackline Road, Gondron Road, and S. Landry Drive.
2. COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that the Public Works Department completed several tasks during the period of July 23, 2025 through August 12, 2025, including culvert cleaning and replacement, road grating and repair, roadside drainage, tree cutting and removal, debris pickup, sidebooming of front ditches, field drainage, as well as many other tasks.
3. COO Broussard announced that Phase I Project C - Road Bond Project Bids are due by Friday, August 22, 2025 at 10:00 a.m., Iberia Parish Courthouse, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, New Iberia, Louisiana. Roads included in this project are: Leonce Theriot Road, Oil Center Drive, Darnall Road, Nelson Canal Road, Joey Street, Brenda Drive, Phyllis Drive, Wanda Street, Ronald Circle, Leon Landry Road, Agnes Broussard Road, Julian Buteaux Road, George Sique Road, Cromwell Drive, Kramer Drive, S. Kramer Drive, Erath Street, Chet Street, and Charlotte Street.
4. COO Broussard also announced that Phase I Project B - Road Bond Project is nearing completion by Berard, Habetz & Associates and is expected to be released for advertisement by the end of August 2025. Roads included in this project are: General Bradley Street, General Chappuis Street, General Collins Street, General Middleton Street, General Paton Street, C. Romero Road, Jack Brooks Road, John L. Dubois Road, Monnet Road, and Soileau Road.
5. COO Broussard announced that Phase I Project A - Road Bond Project is also nearing completion by Sellers & Associates and is expected to be released for advertisement by the end of August 2025. Roads included in this project are: Teche Lake Canal Road, Estate Drive South, Jacqueline Drive, Daspit Road, Candleglow Drive and Northside Road.
6. COO Broussard announced that the Construction Project Contract for South Lewis Street Improvements was signed with Glenn Lege Construction in the amount of \$1,545,609.73. A Pre-Construction Meeting will be held on Tuesday, August 26, 2025.

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- This project will begin within 30 days and is expected to be completed within 90 days.
7. COO Broussard announced that the Turning Lane Improvements and Roadway Widening of LA 3212 have been successfully completed by Glenn Lege Construction. This has enhanced the traffic flow to the First Solar Facility.
  8. COO Broussard advised the Iberia Parish Council that Qualification Statements have been requested for professional engineering services for the jail generator replacement. The submission deadline has been set for Monday, August 18, 2025 at 2:00 p.m.
  9. COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that bidding has been completed for the Bulk Hangar (Phase I) Project at Acadiana Regional Airport. This project has been awarded to TLP Construction in the amount of \$420,000.
  10. COO Broussard advised that advertisements for the Air Traffic Control Tower Rehabilitation Project were advertised on Wednesday, August 13, 2025. The bid deadline has been set for Tuesday, September 9, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.
  11. COO Broussard announced that Highway 90 Sewer Expansion Project is underway in District 1. Contractors Southern Constructors has mobilized and is preparing for the Lift Station construction portion of this project. This project is expected to be completed in 300 days.
  12. COO Broussard advised that Tete Bayou Wastewater Plant Improvement Project has been awarded to Southern Constructor and is expected to begin in September 2025.
  13. COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council the new \$18.7 Million Water Treatment Plant is expected to be completed by the end of September 2025.
  14. COO Broussard announced that the Drainage Maintenance and Coulee Clearing Services Project is currently underway. Southern Constructors has begun clearing Channel M10 from Sugarmill Road to Bayou Teche on Monday, August 11, 2025 and is expected to be completed within 15 working days.
  15. COO Broussard announced that the Public Works Department received a new grapple truck which will help keep Iberia Parish clean.
  16. COO Broussard announced that a Public Hearing will be held on September 15, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. at the Delcambre Shrimp Festival Building, 319 E. Main Street, Delcambre, Louisiana for discussion regarding the Jefferson Island Storage and Hub, LLC applications submitted to the Department of Conservation for approval to drill two Class III Solution-Mining Wells and to convert Class III Wells to Class II Hydrocarbon Storage Wells.
  17. CAO Belanger announced that Iberia Parish Government is currently seeking to hire for the following positions: 1)Office Assistant II - Planning & Zoning; (2) Mosquito Control Specialist - Mosquito Control; 3) Maintenance Worker - Waterworks District No. 3; 4) Building Inspector(Certified Residential and Commercial) - Permits, Planning & Zoning; 5) Public Worker I - Public Works; and 6)Public Safety Telecommunicator/911 - Communications District (E-911). 
