3. Councilman Gachassin stated that the vote in the November 19, 2025 Joint Committee Meeting was unanimous, which included Councilman Natalie Broussard's vote.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Chief Operating Officer Michael Broussard advised that several projects are in various stages of planning, design and/or construction and that he will continue to provide the status of the projects as they occur.
2. COO Broussard advised that the third portion of the Road Project will be advertised next week for Bid Opening on Tuesday, January 13, 2026. Roads in this Phase are as follows: Northside, Daspit, and Teche Lake Canal Roads.

COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that the Administration met on Wednesday, December 10, 2025 with Engineering Consultants to discuss ongoing efforts to develop a Comprehensive Parishwide Drainage Master Plan. A proposal will be presented for review and consideration by the Iberia Parish Council. If accepted, this plan will deliver long-term benefits to Iberia Parish by identifying problem areas, prioritizing improvements, reducing flooding and ensuring our infrastructure can better handle future weather events.

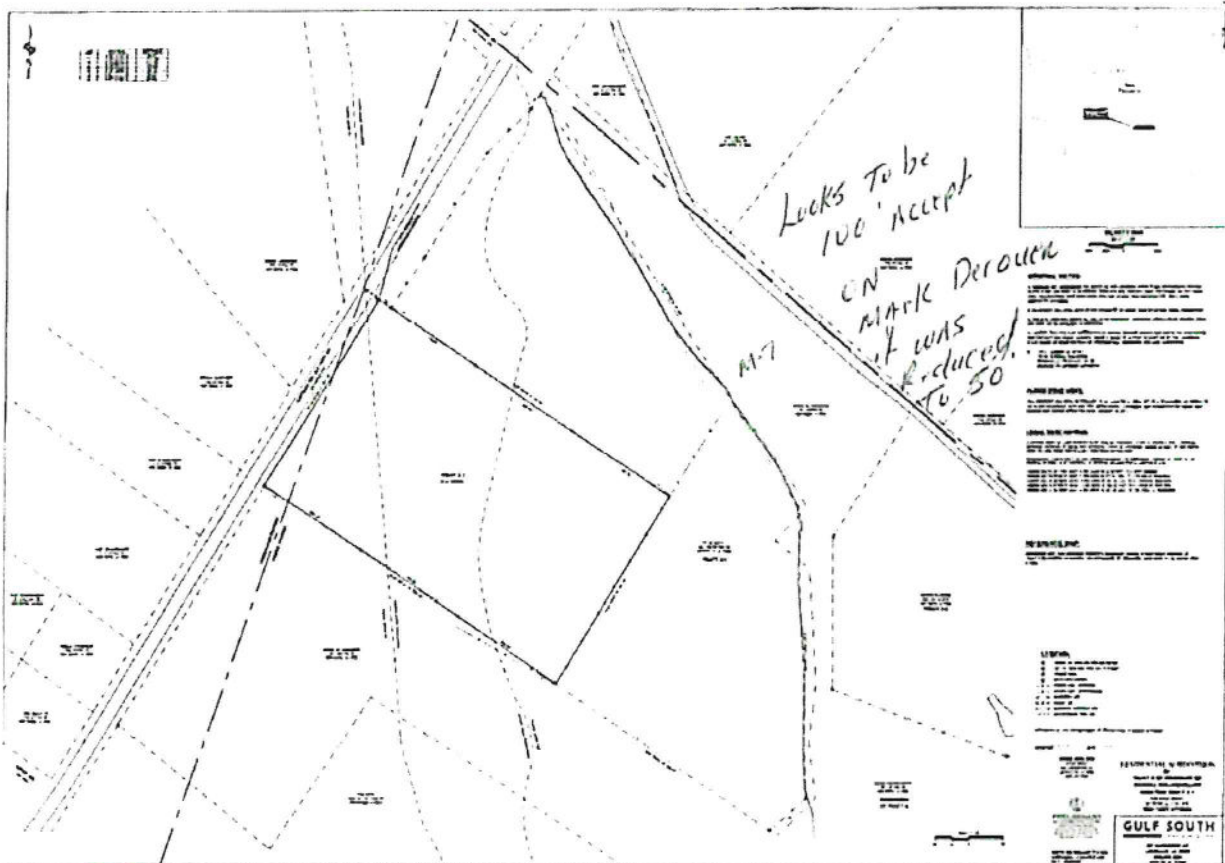
