The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. James P. Trahan, its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Brock Pellerin invited the community to attend the Annual Grand Marais Mardi Gras Parade on Sunday, February 15, 2026 at 1:00 p.m.
2. Councilman Michael Landry announced that the Iberia Parish Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) held a meeting on Wednesday, February 11, 2026 to review the Parish's Emergency Preparedness Operations in an effort to better protect the residents of Iberia Parish for emergency events.
3. Councilman Michael Landry further announced that the Knights of St. Peter Claver will be selling tickets for the fish fry to be held on Wednesday, February 18, 2026 at St. Edward Catholic Church.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. On behalf of Parish President M. Larry Richard, Chief Operating Officer Michael Broussard provided updates to the Iberia Parish Council.
2. COO Broussard advised the Iberia Parish Council that the Public Works Department completed several tasks during the period of January 28, 2026 through February 10, 2026, including culvert repair, tree cutting, removal and debris pickup, road grading, patching and repair, roadside drainage, shoulder repair, and sidebooming of front ditches, as well as many other tasks performed.
3. COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that the Bid Opening for Iberia Parish Animal Control Shelter Project will be held on Thursday, February 5, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. in Council Chambers, 4th Floor, Iberia Parish Courthouse Building.
4. COO Broussard provided an update on the Roadway Improvements Project, Phase I-Project A and stated that crews have completed the overlay portion of the General Streets, including General Bradley, General Chappuis, General Collins, General Middleton and General Patton Street, and will soon begin working on shoulder and pavement markings.
5. COO Broussard continued updates for Roadway Improvements Project, Phase I-Project A and stated that the existing base has been removed and replaced on John Road and is now awaiting asphalt overlay; L. Dubois Road has been reconstructed with the cross drain replaced and is now awaiting asphalt overlay; asphalt patching has been completed on C. Romero Road; and the contractor has completed 50% of patching on L. Dubois Road from Avery Island Road to reconstruct the tie-in.
6. COO Broussard advised that the construction contract for the Roadway Improvements Project, Phase I-Project B was signed on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, with Glenn Lege being awarded the contract. This portion of the Road Improvements Project will include Northside Road, Daspit Road, Teche Lake Canal Road, and Country Lane. Work will begin on Daspit Road in mid-March.
7. COO Broussard provided an update on Roadway Improvements Project, Phase I-Project C and stated that drainage work continues on Leon Landry Road. Upon completion, the contractor will begin work on Leonce Theriot Road.
8. COO Broussard announced that the initial phase of the Hangar Drive Extension Project has begun and should be completed in July of 2026.
9. COO Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that engineering designs are underway for the Gaubert Road Project, with progress made to obtain the right-of-way acquisition of the landowners for completion of this project.

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10. COO Broussard provided a video of Peebles Water Control Structure to allow the Iberia Parish Council to view the substantially completed project. He explained that a leak test on the flood gate was successfully performed. This \$4 Million project will serve as a critical component in our multi-faceted approach to mitigate flood risks in Iberia Parish.

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-02-5313

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE SUGARCANE FESTIVAL BUILDING AND CERTAIN SURROUNDING PROPERTY IN NEW IBERIA CITY PARK AS SURPLUS AND TRANSFERRING THE PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF NEW IBERIA IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S RENOVATION OF AND CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE SUGARCANE FESTIVAL BUILDING.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The City of New Iberia has plans to acquire state capital outlay funds for a renovation of the Sugarcane Festival Building to enhance its use for recreational and cultural opportunities for citizens of Iberia Parish and the City of New Iberia.

SECTION 2. The City of New Iberia is in need of acquiring the Sugarcane Festival Building and certain adjacent properties owned by Iberia Parish Government at New

Iberia City Park, New Iberia, LA 70560 more particularly depicted and described as Parcel A on the plat of the survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Property") in order to complete the proposed renovation of the Sugarcane Festival Building.

SECTION 3. Iberia Parish Government lacks sufficient funding to renovate the Sugarcane Festival Building and wishes to surplus the building and surrounding lands in New Iberia City Park and transfer them to the City in order that the building may be renovated by the City of New Iberia for use by the citizens of Iberia Parish.

SECTION 4. The City of New Iberia has been maintaining and operating recreational facilities available to the public on the Property and will continue to maintain and operate said facilities.

SECTION 5. The City of New Iberia will provide a permanent servitude on certain immovable property owned by the City to the Parish as part of this transfer, as depicted as Parcel D on the plat of the survey attached as Exhibit "A" and the City further warrants that its use of the Sugarcane Festival Building will be for public purposes and to the benefit of the citizens of Iberia Parish.

SECTION 6. That the relative economic or monetary value of the benefits to be derived by each of the parties is not easily susceptible to precise determination or measurement. However, each party has determined that the benefit to be received by that party is fair compensation and sufficient consideration for the agreements made by that party and that each party has a reasonable expectation of receiving at least equivalent benefits or value in exchange for the conveyance, payment and/or agreement made by that party.

SECTION 7. That the Parish President and Iberia Parish Council Members of Iberia Parish, Louisiana, that the Iberia Parish Government does hereby declare the Sugarcane Festival Building and certain property within New Iberia City Park consisting of 11.646 acres (said property being more particularly depicted and described as Parcel A on the plat of survey attached hereto as Exhibit "A") surplus property and hereby authorize the Parish President to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement, by and between Iberia Parish Government and the City of New Iberia, relating to the conveyance to the City of New Iberia of the Sugarcane Festival Building and certain surrounding property, attached as Exhibit "A" and accept the conveyance to Iberia Parish Government of a perpetual servitude on the property described and depicted in Parcel D of the plat of survey attached as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 8. That the Iberia Parish President is also authorized to execute any and all other cooperative endeavor agreements, contracts, documents or other writings necessary to carry out the intent and purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9.
