The Parish Council of Iberia Parish, Louisiana met in Regular Session in the Parish Council Chambers, Main Courthouse Building, New Iberia, Louisiana, on Wednesday, July 24, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. Warren P. Gachassin, Jr., its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Councilman Brock Pellerin informed the Council that he spoke with the State in regards to grass cutting. The area of Admiral Doyle Drive was completed, however, the side boom is currently not working so the grass cutting progress has been halted.
- 2. Councilman Lady Fontenette Brown announced that a Townhall Meeting will be held on Thursday, August 1, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at Mon Ami located at 7304 Highway 90 East, Jeanerette, Louisiana.
- 3. Councilman Lady Fontenette Brown also announced that the Louisiana Police Jury Association received an achievement award at the 2024 NACo Annual Conference and Exposition held on July 12-15, 2024 in Tampa, Florida.
- 4. Councilman James P. Trahan announced that he received a call from Director Kevin Ardoin, Acadiana Crime Lab stating that they received the matching funds from Iberia Parish and thanked the Council for providing these funds. Councilman Trahan further stated that the expected date of completion of the Acadiana Crime Lab Project is August of 2025.
- 5. Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. announced that the next Iberia Parish Council Meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 14, 2024 at 6:00 p.m.
- 6. Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. reminded the public to visit the Iberia Parish Government website at www.iberiaparishgovernment.com to complete the Stormwater Management Survey and view adjudicated properties through Civic Source.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Parish President M. Larry Richard announced that Litter Abatement cleanup was conducted on Saturday, July 13, 2024 with 12 individuals participating. They picked up 59 bags of trash in the areas of Highway 3212 also known as Corporate Drive and Admiral Doyle Drive near Acadiana Regional Airport.
- 2. President Richard informed the Council that from July 10-24, 2024, the Public Works Department completed several tasks including culvert cleaning, road side drainage cleaning, tree cutting and removal, cleanup of illegal dumping, debris pickup, field drainage, grating roads, road patching and repairs, and side booming.
- President Richard stated that Warren P. Gachassin, Jr., Iberia Parish Council Chairman and District 5 Chairman gave a presentation at the Rotary Club of New Iberia held on Wednesday, July 24, 2024. Chairman Gachassin discussed the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between Water and Sewer Department and reviewed completed, current and future projects in Iberia Parish. Chairman Gachassin highlighted successes of in-house inspections and new software for Permits, Planning & Zoning. He also gave information on the road tax and the Comprehensive Road Program and covered ARPA investments in water, sewer, fiber and solid waste improvements.
- 4. President Richard informed the Council that Prescott Marshall, Iberia Parish Homeland Security and Emergency 911 Communications Director also gave a presentation at the Rotary Club of New Iberia, on Wednesday, July 24, 2024. Director Marshall discussed improvements in 911 services, highlighted advancements in mapping and addressed challenges with callers and shared key call performance metrics. He further covered hurricane preparedness efforts in collaboration with GOSHEP and National Weather Services emphasizing the needs to better preparation.

- 5. President Richard announced that the Delta BioFuel Project is near completion and advised that the plant will be powered within the next 30-35 days with pellet production set to begin in the Fall of 2024 with full operation shortly thereafter. He stated that the plant will have an annual capacity to convert over 340,000 metric tons of sugarcane bagasse and is expected to create over 100 jobs with an average salary of \$62,500.
- 6. President Richard informed the Council that there is a high demand for CDL drivers for the Delta BioFuel Project and advised that the detailed hiring plan can be found at deltabiofuel.com/hiring-plan/.
- 7. President Richard thanked the Brian Verret Company for providing aerial drone photographs of the Delta BioFuel Project which were viewed by the Council.
- 8. President Richard advised that construction has begun for the new Water Plant near Acadiana Regional Airport. The site has been cleared and undercut with driveways and building area brought to grade, subsurface drainage has been completed, ditches have been cleaned, with building forms laid out and casings for Well #1 have been drilled and set with preparation for Well #2 to follow. President Richard further advised that this project will provide reinforcement in our commitment to the community in providing a dependable water source.
- 9. President Richard thanked Director of Waterworks District No. 1 Brad Cradeur for overseeing the new Water Plant Project.
- 10. President Richard informed the Council that Louisiana State Senator Bill Cassidy visited Acadiana Regional Airport to announce the \$2 Million Dollar Delta Regional Authority Grant for the East Side Development Project which includes constructing a 200,000 square-foot Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) Facility, expanding aircraft aprons and upgrading infrastructure and essential utilities. President Richard further explained that this will allow for future expansion, ensure economic sustainability and is expected to create hundreds of new jobs in Iberia Parish.
- 11. President Richard thanked Former Councilman Eugene Olivier, Sr. for informing Acadiana Regional Airport Director Maurice "Moe" Songy that the Delta Regional Authority Grant was available for the East Side Development Project.
- 12. President Richard also thanked Acadiana Regional Airport Director Maurice "Moe" Songy for his efforts in applying for and securing the Delta Regional Authority Grant for the East Side Development Project.
- 13. President Richard also announced that a Townhall Meeting will be held on Thursday, August 1, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at Mon Ami located at 7304 Highway 90 East, Jeanerette, Louisiana. The topic of discussion will be community development in Grand Marais with the Honorable Judge Curtis Sigur serving as the guest speaker as well as a number of elected officials expected to be in attendance to share information with the public regarding their efforts.
- 14. President Richard advised that Iberia Parish Government will be hiring two (2) Public Works Public Worker I positions and one (1) Sewerage District No. 1 Wastewater Treatment & Collections Operator position. Employment applications can be found on the Iberia Parish Government website at www.iberiaparishgovernment.com.
- 15. President Richard also reminded everyone to visit the website for Iberia Parish Government which can be viewed at www.iberiaparishgovernment.com.

REPORTS (PARISH OR OTHER GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES):

1. Louisiana State Senator Blake Miguez provided Iberia Parish Council with a legislative update and thanked the Council for their support in the previous election. He stated that his goal is to make Iberia Parish a better place to live by focusing on the crime issue and is working very closely with Governor Jeff Landry to improve the State of Louisiana and the City of New Iberia.

Senator Miguez informed the Council that they attended three (3) Crime Special Sessions and identified crime as one of the major issues in the State of Louisiana and passed legislation specifically which focused on Victim's Rights and holding criminals accountable. They formed Troop Nola and entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Attorney General's Office to prosecute crimes the Louisiana State Police enforces.

Senator Miguez stated he had the opportunity to present the Constitutional Carry Bill which gives law abiding Louisiana citizens the right to carry concealed firearms to defend themselves and their families. In doing so, Louisiana state law had to be realigned with the United States Constitution.

Senator Miguez informed the Council that they passed the Education Saving Account which is the Gator Program to reform education with the goal to give every child an opportunity to receive a better education.

Senator Miguez informed the Council that they had the opportunity to meet with Insurance Commissioner Tim Temple and together they passed 38 bills that addressed automobile, property and commercial insurance premiums in an effort to get the insurance market back in line.

Senator Miguez stated that he is very proud to announce that they brought \$80 Million Dollars to Iberia Parish that went to a number of infrastructure programs with nearly \$150 Millions for future opportunities. In the off-session of Joint Budget Committee, Iberia Parish was funded \$26 Million Dollars to help with the development of the First Solar Project for the relocation of the road and operation of the Port of Iberia Dredging Project.

Senator Miguez further gave a detail of funds allocated to Iberia Parish for road constructions and repairs, more specifically, \$12.75 Million Dollars for road construction on La. Highway 90 to La. Highway 31 between La. Highway 14 and La. Highway 88, \$9.6 Million Dollars for La. Highway 31, \$8.75 Million Dollars for La. Highway 83 from U.S. Highway 90 to Lydia, \$3 Million for U.S. Highway 90 though La. Highway 88 to La. Highway 92, \$1.6 Million Dollars for joint sealing and road repairs from Cemetery Road to La. Highway 347, \$1.3 Million for joint sealing and road repairs for La. Highway 14 from U.S. Highway 90 to Jefferson Island Road, \$1 Million Dollars for Frontage Road, \$450,000 for road repairs to Gobear Road, \$375,000 to overlay Coteau Holmes Road, \$300,000 to build and overlay La. Highway 14 in Delcambre, \$200,000 for La. Highway 668 between La. Highway 671, \$175,000 to build and overlay Lake Dauterive Road to Sidney Blanchard Road, and \$7.85 Million for construction to the other side of La. Highway 86 to North Lewis Street and back to La. Highway 182.

Senator Miguez also stated that funds were also received for projects including, \$10 Million Dollars for Bio-Innovation Lab, \$7.8 Million Dollars for Acadiana Crime Lab, \$5 Million Dollars for the Port of Iberia Dredge Project, \$4 Million Dollars for the Hangar Project at Acadiana Regional Airport,

\$3.5 Million for renovating Iberia Medical Center for improved medical services, \$1.24 Million for Iberia Parish Jail, \$1 Million for improvements to Pepperplex, \$9 Million for Hangar 88 repairs and improvements, \$830,000 for debris removal in the Bayou Teche from St. Martin Parish to Iberia Parish, \$8.10 Million to improve the Waste Water and Sewerage Plant for the Village of Loreauville, \$300,000 for repairs to Iberia Parish Courthouse steps and sidewalks, \$250,000 for improvements to the camera systems in the City of New Iberia, \$125,000 for improvements to Sugarena, and \$75,000 for Youth Service Programs for the City of New Iberia.

Senator Miguez closed stating that he will continue working for Iberia Parish for continued improvements.

A RESOLUTION OF THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL APPROVING THE LOUISIANA INDUSTRIAL TAX EXEMPTION CONTRACT EXHIBIT "A" AMENDMENT FOR BAGWELL ENERGY SERVICES, INC. EXISTING UNDER THE ORIGINAL ITE APPLICATION/CONTRACT #20180323-ITE (INCLUDING CONTRACTS #20180323-A-ITE, #20180323-B-ITE, and #20180323-C-ITE).

WHEREAS, Article 7, Section 21(F) of the Louisiana Constitution authorizes the Board of Commerce and Industry ("BCI"), with the approval of the Governor, to approve contracts under the Industrial Tax Exemption Program ("ITEP"), through which applicants seeking to construct a new manufacturing establishment or install an addition to a manufacturing establishment are awarded an exemption for such facilities from local ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, Through Executive Orders JBE 16-26 and 16-73, Governor John Bel Edwards set forth conditions for approval of exemptions under ITEP contracts including the creation or retention of jobs and payroll and, among other things, review and approval by the local governing authority in which the exemption is contemplated, the parish school board, the municipality (if applicable) and the sheriff; and

WHEREAS, Bagwell Energy Services, Inc. ("Company") submitted an ITEP application to the Louisiana Department of Economic Development ("LED") for the addition of precision fabrication equipment for process industry piping and vessels; installing new bridge cranes; and building a 15,000 square foot addition to its fabrication center, a 24,000 square foot addition to its painting and blasting facility, and a 7,000 square foot alloy shop at 10404 Twin Port Rd in Delcambre, Louisiana totaling an estimated \$3,104,783. Also included was a commitment to creating 150 Jobs, having an annual Payroll of at least \$10,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, The ITEP application for contract was approved by the BCI on June 28, 2019 for an 80% exemption for 5 years and an option to renew the exemption at 80% for an additional 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the Iberia Parish Council passed Resolution No. 2019-118 approving the Company's ITEP Application/Contract #20180323-ITE; and

WHEREAS, the Company's original Job and Payroll commitments were estimated in 2019 prior to a number of events beyond the Company's control that have changed the near- and mid-term forecasts for industry that the Company operates in, as well as the industries that the Company relies upon. Those events include, but or not limited to, the COVID-19 Pandemic, delays in carbon capture projects, delays in wind electricity generation projects, LNG project delays, and national and international policy changes affecting the oil and gas industry as a whole. However, unlike some of the Company's regional competitors, the Company was able to survive, retained their pre-existing Jobs, and remains committed to the local communities that they operate in and reply upon. Furthermore, and in spite of the above challenges, the Company achieved and even surpassed their capital investment estimate by roughly \$1.5 million; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Company's ITEP Contract and Exhibit "A" is needed to adjust the Required Annual Jobs and Required Annual Payroll as stated in Section 4.02 (B) of the Exhibit "A" in order to align with the ongoing expectations of the Company and the Iberia Parish Council; and

All DOTD supplied load posting information concerning a bridge has been critically reviewed by the Parish Engineer prior to load posting; and
- 4. All bridges owned or maintained by the Parish are shown on the attached list in the format specified by the DOTD. Corrections to data supplied to the Parish by the DOTD are noted.
- 5. All bridges owned and maintained by the Parish are accessible to DOTD for all routine bridge inspections. Parish will clear vegetation as required upon DOTD request.
