The Parish Council of Iberia Parish, Louisiana met in Regular Session in the Parish Council Chambers, Main Courthouse Building, New Iberia, Louisiana, on Wednesday, June 11, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. James P. Trahan, its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Councilman Caymen Crappell stated that he attended a meeting along with Parish President M. Larry Richard and Parish Administration on Wednesday, June 11, 2025, in which they discussed the possibility of lower road construction costs.
- 2. Councilman Chad Maturin announced that Waterworks District No. 3 has changed their monthly meeting times from 6:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Meetings will continue to be held every third Monday of each month at 4104 Coteau Road, New Iberia, Louisiana.
- 3. Councilman Natalie Broussard announced that CERT held its Parish Prepared Meeting on Thursday, June 5, 2025 at the Sliman Theatre. Meteorologist Dave Baker and Office of Homeland Security Director Brandon Migues gave updates on what to expect during the hurricane season and CERT gave a presentation on how to be prepared for storms.

4. Councilman Natalie Broussard thanked Lieutenant Billy Nungesser's Office and Volunteer Louisiana for providing items to attendees for the CERT Parish Prepared Meeting.

5. Councilman Michael Landry announced that he has been appointed to serve as the Iberia Parish Liaison to communicate with Parish Officials from the Evacuation Center in Monroe, Louisiana and to inform the community when it is safe to return to Iberia Parish.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Parish President M. Larry Richard acknowledged that CERT did an excellent job presenting at the Parish Prepared Meeting held on Thursday, June 5, 2025 at the Sliman Theatre.

 2. President Richard gave an update regarding the Parish Road Construction Project and emphasized that some roads will be completed before other roads.
- 3. CAO Milton "Bo" Belanger informed the Iberia Parish Council there were 3 participants in the Litter Abatement Program on Saturday, May 31, 2025. A total of 60 bags of trash and other items were collected in the areas of N. College Road and the Overpass at Darnall Road and Highway 90.
- 4. CAO Belanger informed the Iberia Parish Council that Public Works Department completed several tasks during the period of May 28, 2025 through June 10, 2025, including culvert repair, tree cutting and removal, debris pickup, roadside drainage, road patching, repairs and grating, sidebooming of front ditches and slashbusting, as well as many other tasks.
- 5. CAO Belanger announced that members of the Iberia Parish Administration attended a tour of Falgout Canal Floodgate and Elliot Jones Pump Station in Houma, Louisiana. These structures are similar to the flood control features planned for the Delcambre Canal and other commercial canals in Iberia Parish. The site visit is part on the ongoing partnership with CPRA which has included local projects in the 2025-2026 Annual Plan. These improvements are key to protecting our residences in building a stronger, more resilient Iberia Parish.
- 6. Engineer Brooke Neuman, C.H. Fenstermaker & Associates, LLC provided a Flood Drainage Analysis for the Drainage Study Proposal in the Coteau area. The study includes project tasks, cost and schedule in the amount of \$82,500.
- 7. Engineer Mike Pugh, Royal Engineers and Consultant, Inc. provided recommendations for drainage and flood issues related to Tête Bayou, Calumet Cut, Intracoastal Canal, Bayou Teche, and other waterways. He stated that they are working with CPRA to incorporate the flood models into the Flood Control Plan

which will be presented to Iberia Parish Government within the next 90 days.

- 8. CAO Belanger stated that the week of June 15-21, 2025 has been declared Pilez Mosquito Week. The Mosquito Abatement District will set up displays and have prize giveaways for visitors at Iberia Parish Library Branches, including, the Main Library, St. Peter Library, Parkview Library, Lydia Library, and Coteau Library. For helpful mosquito prevention tips, please go to the Mosquito Control section of Iberia Parish Government's website. Please remember to tip and toss any standing water to help control mosquitos in your area.
- 9. CAO Belanger reminded everyone to sign up for Iberia PINS by visiting the Iberia Parish Government website or SMART911.com to receive real-time alerts, notifications and important community updates.

WHEREAS, these companies are all able to compete on a level playing field with companies around the world due to the duty savings realized through the FTZ program, which in turn, helps the local economies in terms of jobs, creating new ones, and retaining the jobs already in place, attracting new businesses, as well as supporting the local vendors with supplies and services; and

WHEREAS, that ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc., centrally located in the entire Gulf Coast, Central America, and Caribbean Operations, whose offices are located at 1309 Unifab Road, New Iberia, LA 70560, providing crane services for their customers around the world, including final assembly, overhauling, engineering support, marine services, and logistics management.

WHEREAS, that ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc. consistently utilizes the services of local third party services; and

WHEREAS, ECI Gulf Coast Parts and Service, Inc. is requesting support for their application to the Foreign Trade Zone Board for a Subzone site within the proposed new zone at Port of Iberia District; and
