A report from Statewide Electrical Services, LLC was reviewed for the month of January 2023 for the operation and maintenance of the District's field. A new pump was installed at the Hwy 87 Lift Station and the motor starter was replaced at the Michelle Lane Lift Station. All other work for the month was primarily routine operation and maintenance.

A report from Staples Engineering; Chandler reported that GIS is presently at 369 manholes completed. Smoke testing was performed at New Horizon Mobile Home Park.

The Director gave his report; we are in the middle of several projects, and all are on schedule. We have received approval from the Water Sector Program to start the Generator Subproject and have an additional seven projects to start construction within the next twenty-four months.
