### PUBLIC COMMENTS

1. Mr. Vince Dorsey and Mr. Shane Walker both spoke in support of Ordinance Summary No. 5250.

2. Mr. Cole Griffin spoke in support of Resolution Summary No.

3. Mr. Matthew Margaglio of Kolder, Slaven and Company presented the Financial Audit Report for fiscal year ending December 31, 2022.

Mr. Margaglio pointed out the four key components, including the reports by the auditors and financial information. These reports consist of the independent reports on financials, internal controls, and federal awards, along with Administration's reports on financial statements and note disclosures. Mr. Margaglio stated that the Parish was issued an unmodified opinion on the financial statements, which is the best opinion that can be issued on audits. He stated that an unmodified opinion was also expressed relating to the Federal Programs. He stated that there were no weaknesses on internal controls nor were there any non-compliance issues noted for this audit.

Mr. Margaglio then reviewed the financial information, noting that revenues totaled about \$35 million while expenditures were about \$34 million, leaving an ending total fund balance of about \$51 million dollars. Key sources of revenue are ad valorem of \$10.1 million, sales taxes of \$8.7 million, and state sources of \$5.9 million. Expenditures by category included 21% for Public Works, 16% for health and welfare, 19% for capital outlay, 17% for general government, 11% for public safety, with everything else, such as debt service and culture and recreation, accounting for the remaining expenditures. Funds within the General Fund included total revenues of \$7 million and expenditures of \$7 million. He also pointed out that Royalty Fund revenues received totaled \$430,627, which were previously up to \$4 million prior to 2014.

WHEREAS, the Iberia Parish Government submitted an application dated November 4, 2020 for funding under the Fiscal Year 2021 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant (LCDBG) Program for a sewer collection system improvements project to fund upgrades and repairs to a portion of the existing sewer collection system in two (2) unincorporated areas of the Parish, specifically the New Horizon Subdivision and a neighborhood along Louisiana Highway 86 south of the Village of Loreauville which have inflow/infiltration problems, all of which are located in the unincorporated areas of Iberia Parish in the jurisdiction of the Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish; and

WHEREAS, LCDBG Contract No. 2000620431 is providing grant funds to the Iberia Parish Government in the amount of \$251,200.00 to fund the construction costs for a sewer rehabilitation project for upgrades and repairs to a portion of the existing sewer collection system in two (2) aforementioned unincorporated areas of the Parish, both within the service area of Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Louisiana Community Development Block Grant program, the Iberia Parish Government desires to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish to transfer ownership, operation and maintenance of the sewer collection system improvements funded under said grant program to Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish once the construction of said project is accepted as 'substantially complete' by the Parish.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Iberia Parish Government that the Parish President, M. WHEREAS, FEMA states that Risk Rating 2.0's "methodology leverages industry best practices and cutting-edge technology to enable FEMA to deliver rates that are actuarially sound, equitable, easier to understand and better reflect a property's flood risk"; and

WHEREAS, the Association of Levee Boards of Louisiana, members of both the Louisiana legislature and the federal legislature, members of state government, numerous Parish Presidents and their Councils, and many other entities in Louisiana and around the nation have grave concerns about the soundness of Risk Rating 2.0's underlying methodology, its failure to properly take into account any of the numerous improvements Louisiana's Levee Boards have made to the flood protection systems, and its catastrophic effect on Louisiana's flood insurance rates and the ability of Louisiana's homeowners to purchase flood insurance; and

WHEREAS, many of those entities have repeatedly raised their concerns to FEMA, have asked FEMA for documentation showing FEMA's underlying methodology, and have been passed from one federal office to the next without receiving any meaningful answers to their questions or documents showing FEMA's underlying methodology; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has denied and continues to deny efforts of those who are trying to protect their interests, the interests of their members, the interests of many Louisiana industries, and the interest of Louisiana citizens, making what is supposed to be "Equity in Action" an inequitable program across the entire State of Louisiana; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Iberia Parish Government joins the Attorney General of Louisiana in litigation against FEMA to challenge Risk Rating 2.0.
