PUBLIC WORKS REPORTS:

1. The Public Works Department Report for Closed Work Orders dated June 14-27, 2023 was emailed to the Council members.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Paul G. Landry requested that the Iberia Parish Council allow Mr. Mike Tarantino, President and CEO of the Industrial Development Foundation, to give an update on the \$100,000,000 investment of Delta Biofuel in Iberia Parish which generates bagasse pellets. Delta Biofuel will start with at least 300 new direct jobs plus hundreds of indirect jobs with the average salary expected to be approximately \$55,000 per year. A sample of the pellet product was made available for viewing by all Council members present.

- Councilman Scott Ransonet introduced and announced that the Loreauville High School Band was invited to perform in the 4th of July Parade in Washington, DC and present a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington Cementery. Students and bank members introduced themselves and included Brennan Derouen, William Stiles, Ethan LaBauve, and Claire Broussard. Mr. Brennan Derouen thanked the community for the support that was given throughout their trip. He explained that fund raising was done through jambalaya sales and shirt sales to pay for their trip. A video presentation of the National Independence Day Parade and the Wreath Presentation Ceremony was displayed and viewed at this time.
- 3. Chairman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. announced the upcoming retirement of Clerk of the Council Brenda P. Bergeron. He explained that a timeline has been created for advertising for the Clerk's position and the vacancy would be placed on Iberia Parish Government's website, social media, and Indeed. It was agreed by general consensus to advertise this upcoming vacancy until July 28, 2023.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

- 1. Chief Administrative Officer Milton Belanger, III, announced that Delta Biofuel held their Ground Breaking Ceremony and plans to bring 126 new direct jobs with an average salary of \$62,500, plus benefits, an additional 149 indirect jobs, for a total of 275 new jobs, and 100 construction jobs. He stated that Delta Biolfuel will take bagasse and create biomass fuel pellets, reducing green house gas emissions, and will be able create 340,000 metric tons of fuel pellets annually. He thanked Delta Biofuel for making a \$1,000,000 plus investment in Iberia Parish and for the jobs they will be providing for Iberia Parish.
- 2. CAO Belanger gave a heartfelt congratulations to the Loreauville High School Band for their outstanding performance in the 4th of July Parade in Washington, DC while representing Loreauville High School and Iberia Parish.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECLASSIFICATION REQUEST FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE CORNER OF BAYOU TO BAYOU AND DANIELLE ROAD, WITH SAID PARCEL BEING REZONED FROM R-2 (MIXED RESIDENTIAL) TO C-2 (COMMERCIAL), LOCATED IN DISTRICT 9, ALL AS REVIEWED AND RECOMMENDED BY THE IBERIA PARISH REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07-5251

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF IBERIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, TO DESIGNATE ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEES OF IBERIA PARISH GOVERNMENT FOR EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE; TO PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY DUTIES, TRAINING, AND PROCEDURES; AND TO OTHERWISE PROVIDE WITH RESPECT THERETO.

THAT THE IBERIA PARISH COUNCIL DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. That the Chapter 2 of the Compiled Ordinances of Iberia Parish, Louisiana is hereby amended to establish the designation of essential employees of Iberia Parish Government as follows:

EMERGENCY EMPLOYEE DESIGNATION

Each full-time employee of Iberia Parish Government and it's agencies, boards, and commissions are designated as essential employees, and may be required to perform emergency duties in the event of an emergency or natural disaster.

ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEE EMERGENCY DUTIES

Essential employees may be required to perform duties outside of their normal job duties for emergency preparedness activities including the mitigation of, preparation for, response to, and or recovery from emergencies or disasters. Essential employees may be required to report to work under the supervision of their director or department head or be reassigned to perform work in other areas as needed.

MANDATORY EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TRAINING

Each essential employee shall report to and participate in emergency preparedness and response training when required by the Parish President or his designee.

CALL IN PROCEDURES

Each essential employee shall follow all emergency and disaster notification and call in procedures approved by the Parish President or his designee. All Iberia Parish Government employees are responsible for maintaining an up to date cellular phone number where they can be contacted on file with Iberia Parish Government's Personnel Department. All employees are required to participate in an emergency notification system designated by Iberia Parish Government.

SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATIONS

Employees found to have violated this policy may be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.

EXEMPTION FROM ESSENTIAL EMPLOYEE STATUS

An employee may individually request an exemption from the requirements of this section, by submitting a written request to the Iberia Parish Government Personnel Department. Employees must submit specific and compelling justification for an exemption. If an employee has a personal, private, confidential exemption request involving, but not limited to, an accommodation, a disability, medical or other confidential issues, the Personnel Department may

gather additional information for review and consultation as needed. The Personnel Department and Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness shall review the exemption request and make a timely recommendation to the Parish President. The Parish President may grant or deny the exemption request on the information provided, modify the employee's assigned emergency duties, or request more information.

- SECTION 2. That if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and/or phrase of this Ordinance or the application thereof is declared unconstitutional, unenforceable or invalid by the judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration or findings shall not affect any of the remaining Ordinance which can be given effect without the unconstitutional, unenforceable or invalid provisions of this Ordinance and to that end, the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable.
- SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Iberia Parish Council and approval by the Parish President in accordance with Section 2-13 of the Iberia Parish Home Rule Charter.

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PARISH PRESIDENT TO MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO THE LOUISIANA BOARD OF COMMERCE REGARDING BAGWELL ENERGY SERVICES, INC.'S INDUSTRIAL TAX EXEMPTION PROGRAM CONTRACT #20180323-A-ITE THAT THE LOUISIANA BOARD OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY TAKE NO ACTION FOR NON-COMPLIANCE FOR PROJECT YEAR 2019 BY BAGWELL ENERGY SERVICES, INC.

WHEREAS, Bagwell Energy Services, Inc. has applied for an Industrial Tax Exemption ("ITE") with respect to Project ID No. 20180323-A-ITE and the Iberia Parish Council adopted Resolution No. 2019-118 on July 24, 2019 in support of said exemption; and

WHEREAS, a timely Annual Certification of Compliance is required to be submitted to the Louisiana Economic Development (LED) each Project Year outlining the following Company Objectives set forth in Section 4.02 (B):

Project Year - 2019 Required Jobs - 20 Required Payroll - \$1,400,000.00

WHEREAS, a notice has been received from LED that Bagwell's Annual Certification of Compliance was received by the deadline set forth in Section 7.02 and upon review, the Company's actual Annual Jobs and Payroll was 24 jobs with Payroll of \$1,028,843; and

WHEREAS, LED has advised that Iberia Parish Government may wish to defer any decision or action on Bagwell's non-compliance for Project Year 2019 to the Louisiana Board of Commerce and Industry or to make a recommendation for non-compliance; and

WHEREAS, LED has advised that the Iberia Parish Government may select one of the following options:

- (a) to reduce the term of the exemption (current term is five (5) years); or
- (b) to reduce the annual percentage of the exemption (current percentage is 80); or
- (c) to terminate the exemption; or
- (d) defer any decision or action for non-compliance for Project Year 2019 by Bagwell Energy Services, Inc. to the Louisiana Board of Commerce and Industry; or
- (e) to recommend that the Louisiana Board of Commerce and Industry take no action for non-compliance for Project year 2019 by Bagwell Energy Services, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Administration is recommending that options (a) through (c) be discussed to determine the option to be selected and recommended to LED in order that the Administration may forward this Resolution to LED in response to said notice.
