

PROCEEDINGS FROM THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SEWERAGE DISTRICT NO. 1 OF IBERIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, TAKEN AT A REGULAR MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 2026

The Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish, Louisiana, met in Regular Session at the Iberia Parish Sewerage District No. 1 office, 2617 Northside Road, on Tuesday, March 24, 2026, at four o'clock p.m.

Gage Guidry called the meeting to order with the following members present: Gage Guidry, Eddie Chretien, William Labauve, Sy Bodin, and Larry Darby, Jr.

Also, present were Chandler Staples, Staples Engineering; Scott Landry, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC; and Darius Colar, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC.

It was moved by Chretien, seconded by Labauve, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby approve the minutes taken at the Regular Meeting held on February 24, 2026.

This motion having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

A report from Scott Landry, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, was presented regarding the operation and maintenance of Plant No. 3 for the month of March 2026. Preventative maintenance was performed in several areas of the plant, including the digester blowers, EPW pumps and motors, Clarifier No. 2 gearbox and motor, mechanical bar screen, and bridge aerators. CL<sub>2</sub> and SO<sub>2</sub> ejectors and regulators were cleaned, and CCC No. 1 was drained and rinsed. EPW No. 2 pump and motor were installed and are operating well. A new pump and motor have been ordered for the No. 1 side. In preparation for hurricane season, maintenance for the Plant No. 3 generator has been scheduled, and the fuel tank has been topped off. A total of 246,600 gallons were wasted between February 19, 2026, and March 16, 2026.

A report from Darius Colar, Statewide Electrical Services, LLC, was presented regarding the operation and maintenance of the District's field for the month of March 2026. Work for the month consisted primarily of routine operations and maintenance, including installation of a new pump and completion of wiring and testing at 1501 Troy Road; installation and programming of a new SCADA system at Orleans Trailer Park Lift Station; pump replacement and testing at Coastal Drilling Lift Station; installation of a new 15 HP Liberty pump, cleaning of hose and floats, and return to service at Westgate High School Lift Station; and replacement of a burnt pump,

reprogramming of the SCADA system, and return to service at Rochon Lift Station. The vacuum truck was utilized at the Ridgeway contact chamber, Beau Fleur contact chamber, and Exxon Lift Station.

A report from Staples Engineering was presented for the month of March 2026. The UL Lift Station relocation project is approximately 15–20% complete and remains on track for a June completion date, with progress currently pending completion of required background checks for construction personnel. The Hwy 90 project is approximately 60% complete and is anticipated to come in under budget; therefore, the engineer and Director are evaluating options to utilize remaining funds to extend sewer service in the area. Matthew Broussard has been trained in the use of GIS equipment and has resumed mapping of the remaining manholes.

The Director gave his report. He stated that the Breaux Estates treatment plant was brought online on March 24, 2026. He reported that there has been no change to the Plant No. 3 upgrades due to long lead times for materials. The Hwy 88 Ravenwood Subdivision is expected to be incorporated into Sewerage District No. 1 once specifications are complete. The first phase will include 45 lots. He further noted that the Tete Bayou and City of New Iberia cost share for 2026 is 60.8% for the City and 39.2% for the Sewerage District. He reported that the 2025 financials are under review with administration. A finalized report will be submitted to the Board once complete. Additionally, the RFQ for engineering services for the anticipated wastewater treatment plant at the airbase was published on March 25, 2026. The submission deadline is April 22, 2026.

It was moved by Darby, seconded by Labauve, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby approve tabling consideration of the resolution acknowledging receipt and review of the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention (MWPP) audit for 2025 until the April meeting.

This motion having been submitted to a vote, the vote thereon was as follows:

It was moved by Bodin, seconded by Darby, that the Board of Supervisors of Sewerage District No. 1 does hereby approve a resolution giving the Executive Director final approval to accept the sewerage treatment system at Thibodeaux Mobile Home Park, LLC, located at 6711, 6719, and 6805 Fremin Road, into Sewerage District No. 1 of Iberia Parish's collection system through an Act of Dedication. All required documents, surveys, and approvals have been completed and verified.
