The Parish Council of Iberia Parish, Louisiana met in Regular Session in the Parish Council Chambers, Main Courthouse Building, New Iberia, Louisiana, on Wednesday, November 19, 2025, at 6:01 p.m.

The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. James P. Trahan, its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Lady Fontenette Brown announced that Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana has officially opened its Jeanerette location of Raintree Market at 1001 East Main Street, Jeanerette, Louisiana on Wednesday, November 19, 2025.
2. Councilman Michael R. Landry announced that St. Edwards Church in conjunction with the Knights of Peter Claver will be sponsoring a food drive beginning on Sunday, November 23, 2025. They will be giving food out to the needy during the Thanksgiving Holidays.
3. Councilman Marcus "Bruce" Broussard announced that he and Parish President M. Larry Richard attended Cajun Industries' Grand Opening on Wednesday, November 19, 2025. Councilman Broussard further stated that Cajun Industries, LLC will bring approximately 600-800 jobs to the Port of Iberia and that he was very thankful for this development especially during the holiday season.
4. Councilman Marcus "Bruce" Broussard also wished the area football teams good luck in the playoffs.
5. Councilman Scott Ransonet stated that he had the opportunity to attend a tour at First Solar and was very impressed with the equipment in their facility. Councilman Ransonet further stated that First Solar has created approximately 1,000 jobs for Iberia Parish.
6. Councilman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. stated that fortunately District 14 is beginning to see the Road Construction Project come into effect and requested that Parish President M. Larry Richard provide an update for this project.
7. Councilman Warren P. Gachassin, Jr. stated that the drainage portion of the Lewis Street Overlay Project is close to completion. He also stated that the overlay project will begin next week and is expected to be completed during the second week of December 2025.
8. Councilman Lady Fontenette Brown commended First Solar for their dedication in hiring local employees and that she has many constituents working at First Solar and are very appreciative of their jobs.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Chief Operating Officer Michael Broussard informed the Iberia Parish Council that five individuals participated in the Litter Abatement Program on Saturday, November 15, 2025. A total of 70 bags of trash, tires and mattresses were collected in the areas of N. Dubois Road and Nelson Canal Road.
2. COO Broussard advised that the Public Works Department completed several tasks during the period of November 12-18, 2025, including debris pickup, field and roadside drainage, road grating, patching and repair, sidebooming of front ditches, tree cutting and removal, as well as many other tasks.
3. COO Broussard congratulated Director of Homeland Security Brandon Miguez, Clerk of the Council Carrie D. Terry, and Councilman Michael R. Landry for completing the Leadership Iberia Program thru the Iberia Parish Chamber of Commerce. COO Broussard further explained that this program is designed to strengthen leadership, teamwork and engagement throughout Iberia Parish.
4. COO Broussard gave an update on Peebles Coulee Flood Control Structure and stated that construction continues following the slab foundation completion. Crews have moved into the

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- construction and reinforcement phase of the wingwall and headwall foundations. COO Broussard further stated that in the coming weeks, the contractor will pour the shallow wall for these wall structures. This project is currently estimated at 52% completion.
5. COO Broussard announced that the First Solar Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will take place on Friday, November 21, 2025 at 1:00 p.m. COO Broussard further stated that this event marks a major milestone for our community to celebrate the launch of one of the largest economic developments in Iberia Parish's history. This \$1.1 Billion manufacturing facility represents a significant investment in local industry and job creation supported by infrastructure improvements made by Iberia Parish Government.
 6. COO Broussard announced that Iberia Parish Government is currently seeking to hire for the following positions: 1) Network Administrator/IT Support - Information Technology; 2) Part-Time Office Assistant I - Acadiana Fairgrounds; 3) Maintenance Worker - Acadiana Fairgrounds; 4) Mosquito Control Specialist - Mosquito Control; 5) Public Worker I - Public Works; and 6) Public Safety Telecommunicator 911 - Communications District (E-911). WHEREAS, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) opened Lake Bussey Brake Wildlife Management Area (WMA) in Morehouse Parish in 2020 after an extensive renovation of the lake by Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF); and

WHEREAS, since then the WMA has become one of the premiere recreational and fishing destinations not only for the local residents but also for visitors from surrounding states and Bussey Brake has attracted sportsmen, outdoor enthusiasts, and tourists and sparked economic development in Morehouse Parish as a result of the renovation of the lake and its designation as a Wildlife Management Area; and

WHEREAS, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries this summer proposed a much needed renovation plan for Spanish Lake which lies in both St. Martin and Iberia Parishes. Much of the plan is modeled on the Bussey Brake renovation; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries (LDWF) has documented that fish habitat is degraded by siltation and that water quality is poor in Spanish Lake; and
