The Parish Council of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana, was duly convened as the Governing Authority of the Parish of Iberia by Mr. James P. Trahan, its Chairman, who announced that the Council was now ready to conduct its business.

COUNCIL MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Councilman Scott Ransonet announced that Le Grand Réveil Acadien Week will be celebrated on Monday, October 13, 2025 from 10:00 a.m. till 5:00 p.m. at Vermilionville Historic Village, 300 Fisher Road, Lafayette, Louisiana. The community is invited to attend the event.
2. Councilman Marcus "Bruce" Broussard announced that the 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Championship Gumbo Cookoff will be held October 11-12, 2025 in Bouligny Plaza, New Iberia, Louisiana. The community is invited to attend the event.

PARISH PRESIDENT ANNOUNCEMENTS

1. Chief Administrative Officer Milton "Bo" Belanger advised that the Public Works Department completed several tasks during the period of September 24, 2025 through October 27, 2025, including culvert replacement, debris pickup, field and roadside drainage, road grating and repair, sidebooming of front ditches, and tree trimming, as well as many other tasks.
2. CAO Belanger advised that Bid Opening was held on October 2, 2025 for Phase I - Project A of the Road Bond Project for the following roads: Teche Lake Canal, Estate Drive South, Jacqueline, Daspit, Candleglow, and Northside. Two bids were received and are currently being reviewed by Berard, Habetz & Associates.
3. CAO Belanger announced that the preliminary right-of-way plat of Gaubert Road Project is nearing completion. The finalized plat is expected to be completed by Sellers & Associates next week.
4. CAO Belanger advised that Bid Opening was held on Tuesday, October 7, 2025 for the UL Lift Station Relocation Project. Four bids were received and are currently being reviewed by Staples Engineers & Consulting. The estimate construction cost for this project is \$769,300.
5. CAO Belanger informed the Iberia Parish Council that a Pre-Bid Meeting was held on Wednesday, October 8, 2025 for the Acadiana Regional Airport Air Traffic Control Tower Rehabilitation Project. Bids for this project are due on Monday, October 27, 2025.
6. CAO Belanger advised that the MRO Hangar Site Surcharge Package has been advertised for bids to be accepted on Wednesday, October 8, 2025. A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 15, 2025 at the Iberia Parish Airport Authority. Bids will be due on Thursday, November 6, 2025.
7. CAO Belanger announced that the 2026 Special Finance Meetings will take place on the following dates: Monday, October 13, 2025; Monday, October 20, 2025; and Monday, October 27, 2025 to discuss the 2026 Proposed Budgets. Public Hearing and Adoption of the 2026 Proposed Budgets will take place on Wednesday, December 3, 2025. All Special Finance Meetings will begin at 6:00 p.m.

WHEREAS, Iberia Parish Government has an opportunity to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement between the State of Louisiana Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development and Iberia Parish Government regarding State Project No. H.014278, closing Parish Road 101 at LA 85 and detour of Parish Road 101 to LA 85 via Parish Road 101, Ozenne Road, Darnall Road, and U.S. 90, to provide for the effective date thereof; and to otherwise provide with respect thereto; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to cooperate with one another for the public purposes stated herein in establishing the aforesaid temporary detour route from Parish Road 101 to LA 85 on the terms and conditions hereinafter provided; and
